DOG TAGS – BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

By-law enforcement officers will be conducting door-to-door canvassing during the months of May and June with respect to 2010 dog tags.

All dog owners within The Municipality of Chatham-Kent are reminded to purchase a dog tag each year by March 1st. Municipal By-law 176-2005 requires that all dog owners obtain a municipal dog tag for their dog(s).

Dog tags can be purchased at the Civic Centre or any other Municipal Service Centre within Chatham-Kent. Tags range from \$25.00 for dogs that are spayed/neutered and have rabies shots to \$55.00 when none of this has been done.

Dog owners could risk being fined \$240.00 for failing to purchase a tag. For further information, please contact your local service centre or Licensing Services at 519-360-1998.
