DOG TAGS - PAYMENT DUE BY MARCH 1, 2010

All dog owners within The Municipality of Chatham-Kent are reminded to purchase a dog tag by Monday, March 1, 2010. Municipal By-law 176-2005 requires that all dog owners obtain a municipal dog tag for their dog(s).

Dog tags can be purchased at the Civic Centre or any other Municipal Service Centre within Chatham-Kent. Tags range from \$25.00 for dogs that are spayed/neutered and have rabies shots to \$55.00 when none of this has been done. Dog owners that wait until after March 1, 2010 to purchase a tag will be subject to an additional \$10.00 late charge.

Dog owners could risk being fined \$240.00 for failing to purchase a tag. For further information, please contact your local Municipal Service Centre or Licensing Services at 519-360-1998.

NOTICE OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT

Local Improvement Act Section 6 Phyllis Avenue and Buckingham Avenue Community of Chatham

Take notice that:

- The Council of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent intends to construct a Curb and Gutter improvement on Phyllis Avenue from King Street West to Phillip Street and Buckingham Avenue from King Street West to Phillip Street in the Community of Chatham as a local improvement and intends to specially assess a part of the cost upon the land abutting directly on the work and upon the land that is immediately benefited by the work.
- The estimated cost of the Phyllis Avenue work is \$28,000 and the estimated cost of the Buckingham Avenue work is \$28,000.
- The estimated lifetime of the work is ten (10) years.
- The special rate per metre frontage is \$85.
- The special assessment may be paid in ten (10) annual installments.
- The municipality has received a sufficient petition under clause 7(2)(c) with respect to this work as determined under Section 10 of O. Reg. 586/06.
