NOTICE OF INTENT TO DESIGNATE

IN THE MATTER OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT
The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter 0.18 as amended, provides that the Municipal Council may pass a by-law designating property within the boundaries of the municipality to be of cultural heritage value and interest.

The Council of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent hereby gives Notice of Intent to designate the following:

Description:

Bothwell Cemetery is an active and municipally owned cemetery, located at 15258 Longwoods Road, legally described as Part Lot 13 on the River Range, in the Community of Zone, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, for its cultural heritage value and interest.

Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest:

The property was established in the early 1850's by the Honourable George Brown, as the burial grounds for the newly established Town of Bothwell. The use of markers and monuments perpetuate the memory of the individuals interred within its grounds, as well as provide us with a vast amount of insight into the lives of the inhabitants of Bothwell and the surrounding rural community, while its quiet and peaceful surroundings contribute to the overall culture of its natural landscape. The Bothwell Cemetery is also of value as a good example of a 19th century south-western cemetery, with its stone gateposts, which mark the walking entrance to the original section, were donated by the Women's Institute of Bothwell in 1939 and constructed of local stone from the Thames River.

Any person may, within 30 days of the date of this Notice, serve on the Clerk, a Notice of Objection in writing, setting out the objection and all relevant facts. The last day for filing a notice of objection shall be Friday, July 2, 2010. Where a Notice of Objection has been served, the Council of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
