Chatham-Kent Energy is seeking Proposals from qualified Bidders with proven expertise and experience in the design, procurement, installation and construction of rooftop and ground mount solar PV systems including obtaining Renewable Energy Approval from the Ministry of the Environment for the ground mount applications. The Bidders shall be capable of providing full construction and project management services to bring the installed systems into commercial operation. The electrical energy output from the solar PV system will be sold to the OPA under the Feed-In-Tariff program. At the completion of the installation, the solar PV systems will be owned and operated by Chatham-Kent Energy.

Based on the submissions, Chatham-Kent Energy shall enter into an agreement with the successful Bidder for the Project by selecting one or multiple sites based on economic viability.

Local Improvement Act Section 6
Harvey Street - Community of Chatham

Take notice that:

- The Council of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent intends to construct a Curb and Gutter improvement on Harvey Street, from Robertson Avenue to Inshes Avenue in the Community of Chatham, as a local improvement and intends to specially assess a part of the cost upon the land abutting directly on the work and upon the following land that is immediately benefited by the work.
- The estimated cost of the Harvey Street work is \$25,245 of which \$13,952 is to be paid by the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent.
- The estimated lifetime of the work is ten (10) years.
- The special rate per metre frontage is \$85.
- The special assessment may be paid in ten (10) annual installments.
- The municipality has received a sufficient petition under clause 7(2)(c) with respect to this work as determined under Section 10 of O. Reg. 586/06.

*BBQ propane tanks (20 or 30 pounds only) and car batteries will be accepted.

PLEASE NOTE:

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:

HOW:

- All material must be clearly-labelled, sealed containers no larger than 20 litres (Containers will NOT be returned)

- The maximum quantity accepted is a total of 50 litres of waste material.
