The Chatham-Kent municipal election will be held on Monday, October 25, 2010.

You must be on the Voter's List in order to vote and receive your Voter Identification Notice (VIN) card. This card provides information on where and when you can vote.

VIN cards will be mailed out by mid September, 2010.

You can verify that your name is on the Voters' List and where you will be voting for the 2010 municipal election by accessing the Chatham-Kent Internet Voter Lookup (IVL) at www.ckelection.com, by calling 519.360.1998 or by visiting any Municipal Centre and Municipal Information Centre.

Please note to vote at either the Advance Vote or Election Day (October 25, 2010) you must bring identification that shows your name, qualifying address and signature.

2010 MUNICIPAL ELECTION NOTICE OF NOMINATIONS

Notice is hereby given to the municipal electors of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent that Nominations may be filed for the following offices:

Mayor, Ward Councillors, School Board Trustees for Lambton Kent District School Board (LKDSB), St. Clair Catholic District School Board (SCDSB), French Language Catholic Board, (Conseil Scolaire de district des Ecoles Catholiques Du Sud-Ouest) and French Language Public Board (Conseil scolaire de district du Centre-Sud-Ouest, CSDCSO)

Nominations are to be in the prescribed form and may be filed at the Civic Centre, any Municipal Centre and Municipal Information Centre in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, or in the case of a School Board, in the office of the Clerk designated to receive nominations for that particular office.

A Nomination must be signed by the Candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent on any day before **September 10, 2010**, during regular office hours or on **September 10, 2010 (Nomination Day)**, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

A prescribed Nomination Filing Fee of \$200.00 for the Head of Council and \$100.00 for all other offices payable by cash, certified cheque or money order must accompany the Nomination Form. A Candidate must be nominated prior to raising campaign funds or incurring campaign expenses.

NOTICE OF BY-LAW EXEMPTION REQUEST
