DWQMS Element 18 – Emergency Management

Purpose

This Policy outlines the procedure for maintaining a state of emergency preparedness that identifies potential emergencies and covers response and recovery, training and testing, responsibilities, and communications.

Scope

This Policy relates to Emergencies that directly relate to the safety of drinking-water and the Public Utilities Commission for the Municipality of Chatham-Kent (C-K PUC) drinking-water systems.

Policy

1.0 Emergency Preparedness and Response

1.1 A procedure has been established to maintain a state of emergency preparedness that includes:

- Potential emergency situations and service interruptions that might ultimately impact drinking-water safety.
- Processes for emergency response and recovery
- Emergency preparedness, through training and testing
