Using Your Library

Residents of Chatham-Kent:

Membership is free to all who live, attend school or own property in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent. With a current CKPL card you can borrow and return materials from any of our 11 locations.

Municipal Information Desks are located at the following branches: Bothwell, Highgate, Merlin, Thamesville and Wheatley. Stop in to pay your property taxes, PUC bills, to get a dog license and more.

With a current CKPL card you can obtain a library card from Sarnia-Lambton, Essex, Middlesex and St. Thomas.

Residents with a current card from any of these systems can obtain a library card from CKPL.

Non-Residents:

Our non-resident fee for adults is \$25 per year and \$15 for six months.

Library Card

To register for a library card at any branch of the Chatham-Kent Public Library all you need is valid identification with your **current** address. Memberships are renewed annually by showing valid ID. All fees and fines must be paid before membership can be renewed.

You are responsible for the care of all library materials loaned to you. Library privileges may be revoked when fines are over the maximum allowed. Abuse of library rules, materials or refusal to pay fines/charges may result in loss of your library privileges.
