**Re: WALLACEBURG SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION PHASE 2
Chatham-Kent PUC**

Dear Property Owner/Resident:

The Public Utilities Commission for Municipality of Chatham-Kent has awarded the contract for the Wallaceburg Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project - Phase 2 to Clark Drainage Contractors Ltd.

Dillon Consulting Limited has been retained by the Municipality of Chatham-Kent to assist during the implementation of this project by providing contract administration and construction observation services. This contract includes the new sanitary sewer including new private services to the property line and any related restoration.

The Contractor will begin installing the new sewer and services September 27, 2010 and will advance in the areas as listed below. These works will be completed on or before November 19, 2010.

Napier Street	Mary Street	Thomas Avenue
Dundas Street	Mary Street	Thomas Avenue
Park Street	Napier Street	Dundas Street
Elizabeth Street	Camp Street	William Street

In order to safely and efficiently construct these infrastructure improvements, various intersecting roadways in the construction limits noted above will be closed during construction, with local and emergency vehicle access maintained at all times. During various stages of the work, direct access to driveways may be restricted for short durations.

We appreciate the inconvenience such road closures will cause, particularly in terms of disruptions to your property access. Although this road closure is unavoidable based on the required scope of construction, every effort will be made to minimize the inconveniences and to provide you with sufficient advance notice when such disruptions are unavoidable.

The current schedule for roadside placement of garbage, yard waste and recycling will remain unchanged. In areas where access for municipal collection services is not available due to construction, the Contractor will collect materials placed at the roadside and deposit these in an appropriate area for collection.

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We request that you inform Dillon's on-site representative if you have any knowledge of any storm and/or sanitary sewer connections servicing your respective property, as well as the location of any sprinkler systems that may exist within the municipal boulevard.

The majority of the homes on these streets currently have a sanitary service connection to the road and these will be reconnected. The properties on the east side of Napier Street and west side of Dundas Street are currently serviced from a rear yard sanitary sewer. If you own one of these properties you will have a wooden stake marker placed on you property to show the location of a proposed sanitary sewer connection in the front of your home. You are not required to connect to this new sanitary service connection at this time and this connection is provided for future use.

If you have a stake placed on your property and would like your sanitary connection in a different location, we ask that you speak to one of Dillon's on-site representatives for adjustment (identified by a white hard hat).
