Highlights: Canadian Community Health Survey (CCHS), 2007, Chatham-Kent Health Unit, Ontario

- Higher incidence of diabetes, arthritis, asthma, high blood pressure than Ontario average
- Higher incidence of smoking than Ontario average and smokers have increased to 28.7% in 2007 from 24.4% in 2005
- Higher obesity and lower physical activity reported than Ontario average
- Lower fruit and vegetable consumption than Ontario average
- Stronger sense of belonging to the community than Ontario average, has increased to 72.4% in 2007 from 64.9% in 2003
- Lower perceived life stress than Ontario average
- Lower binge drinking reported than Ontario average
- More people get the flu shot than Ontario average

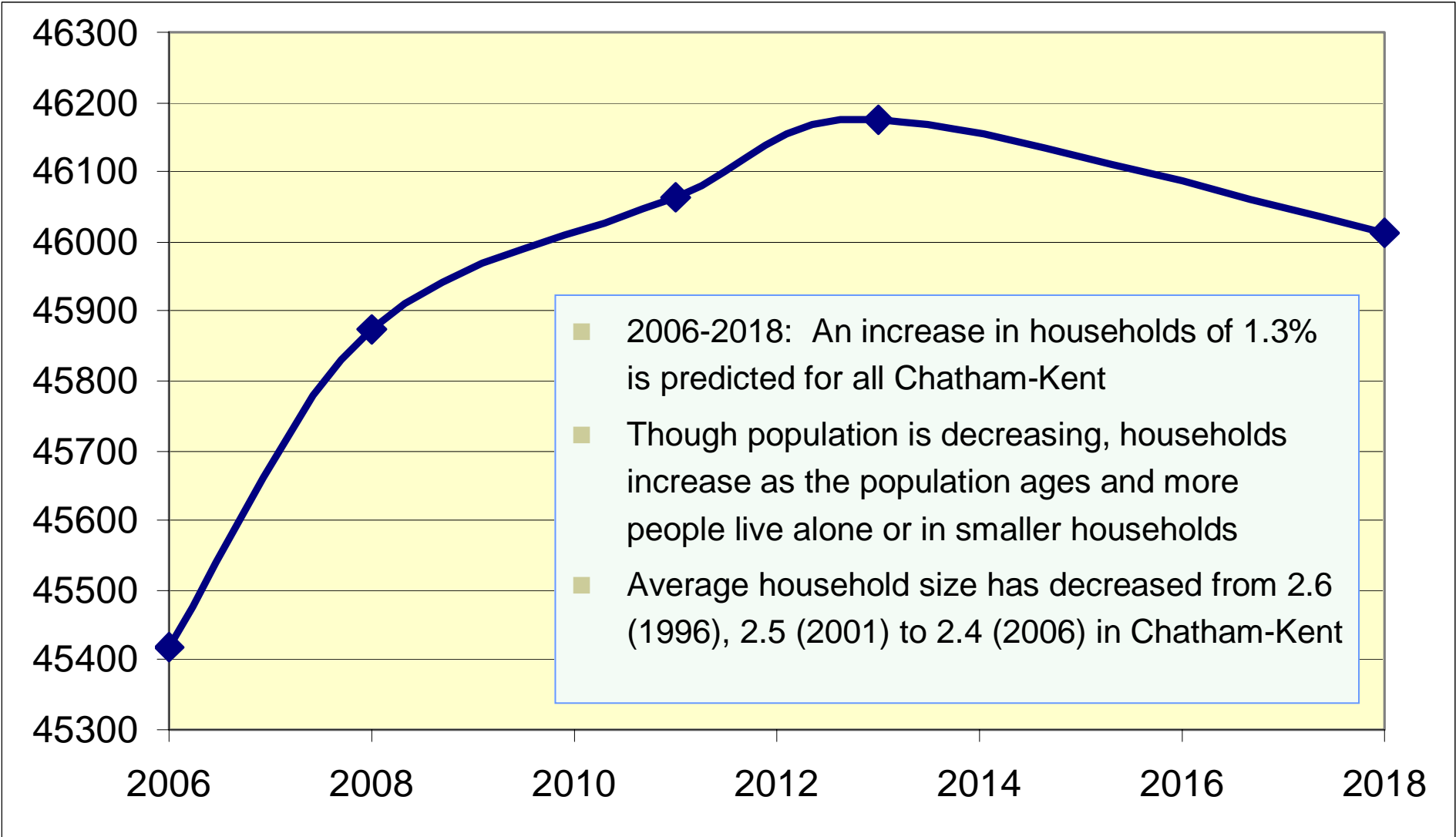

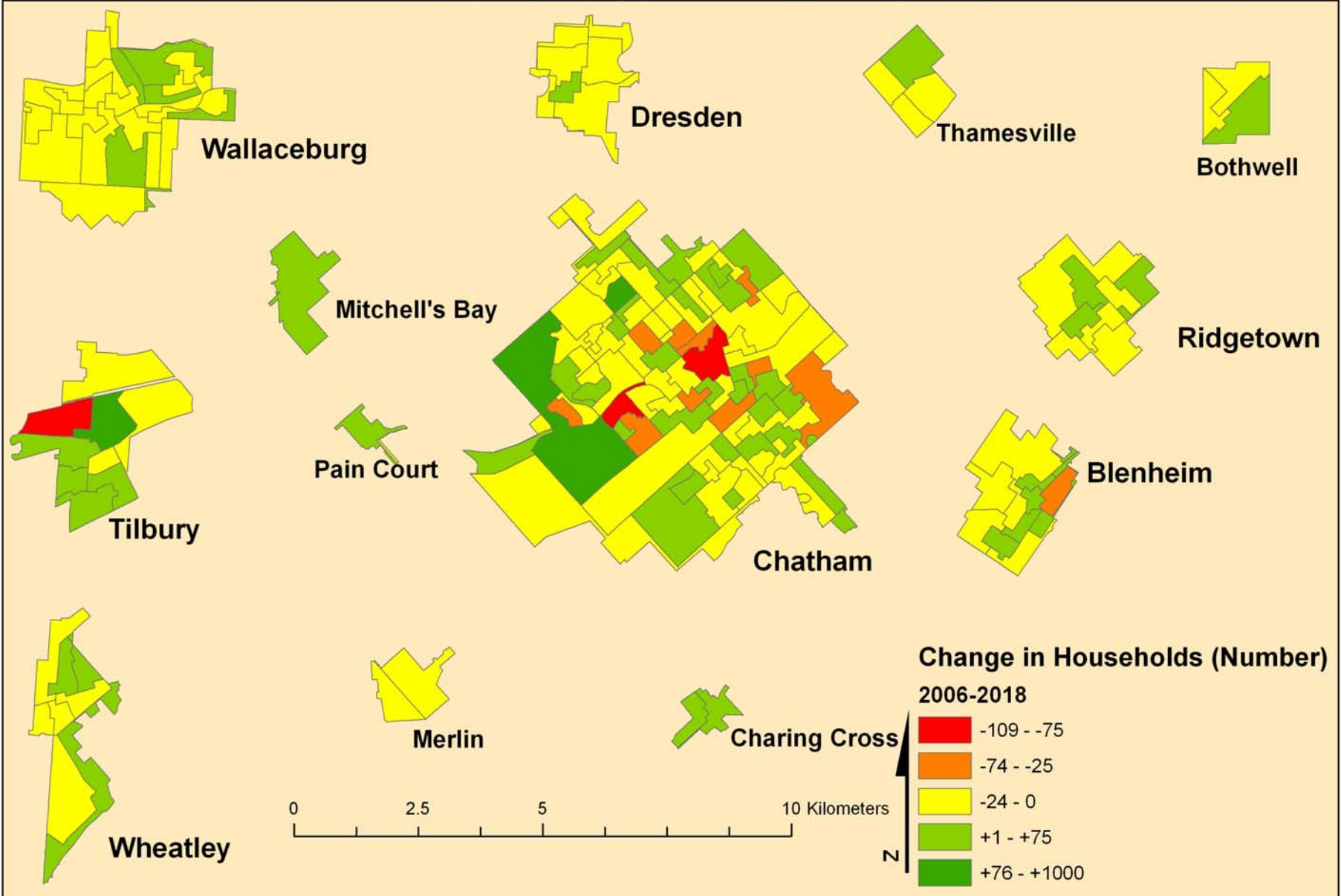
Household Trends for Chatham-Kent, 2006-2018

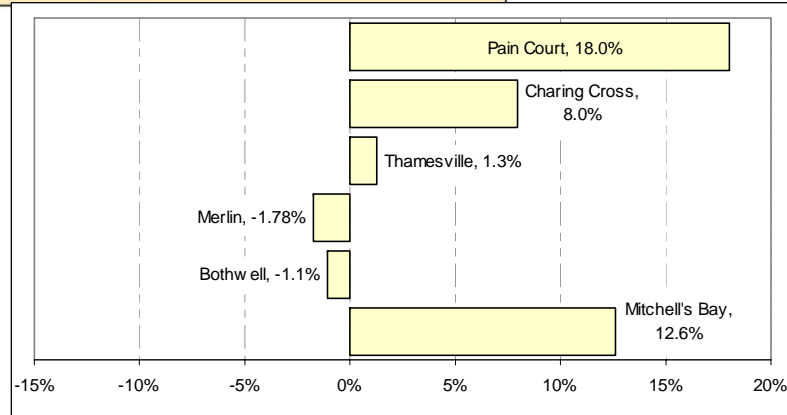
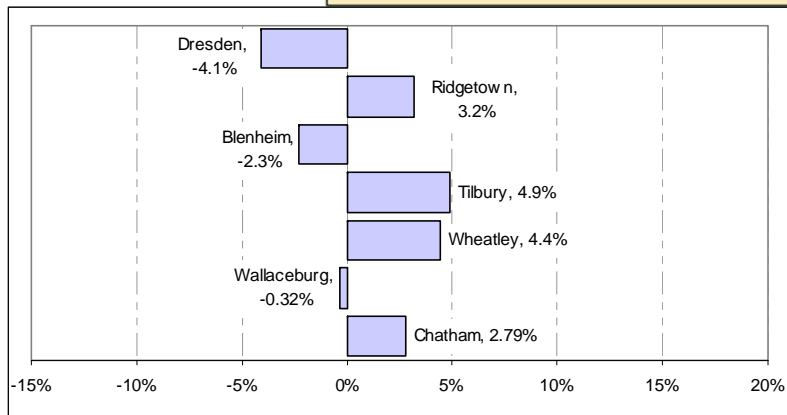
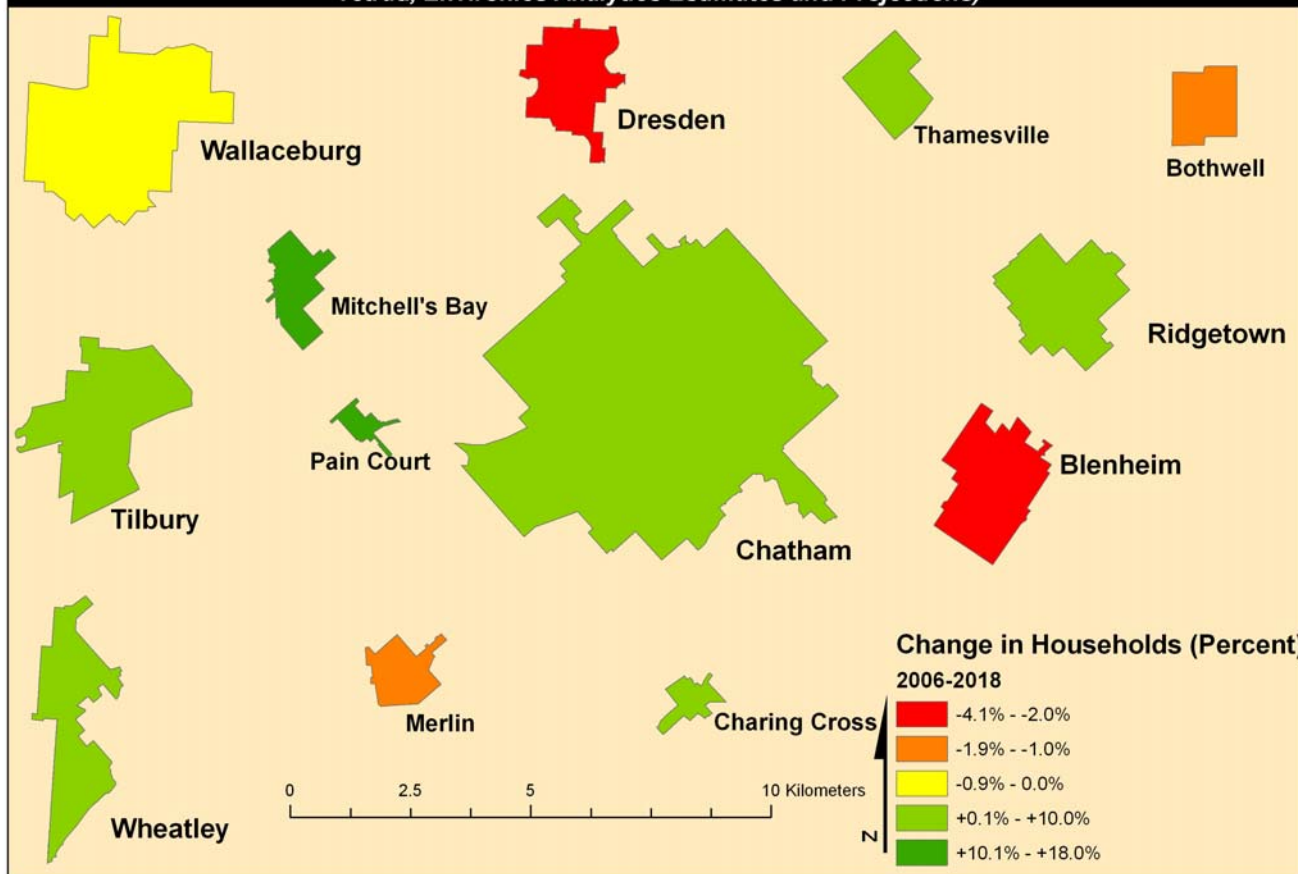
Estimated Change in Number of Households, 2006-2018

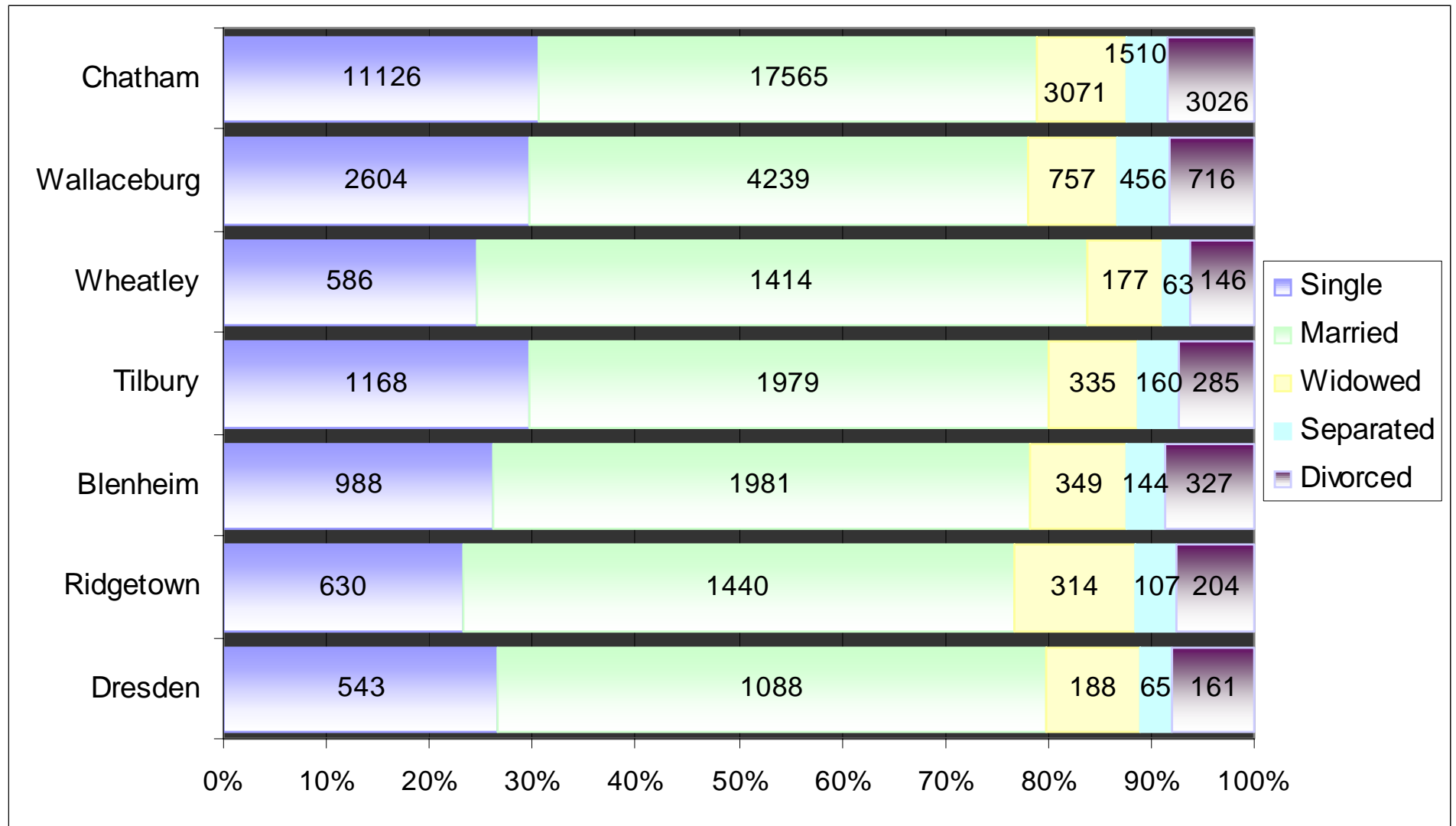

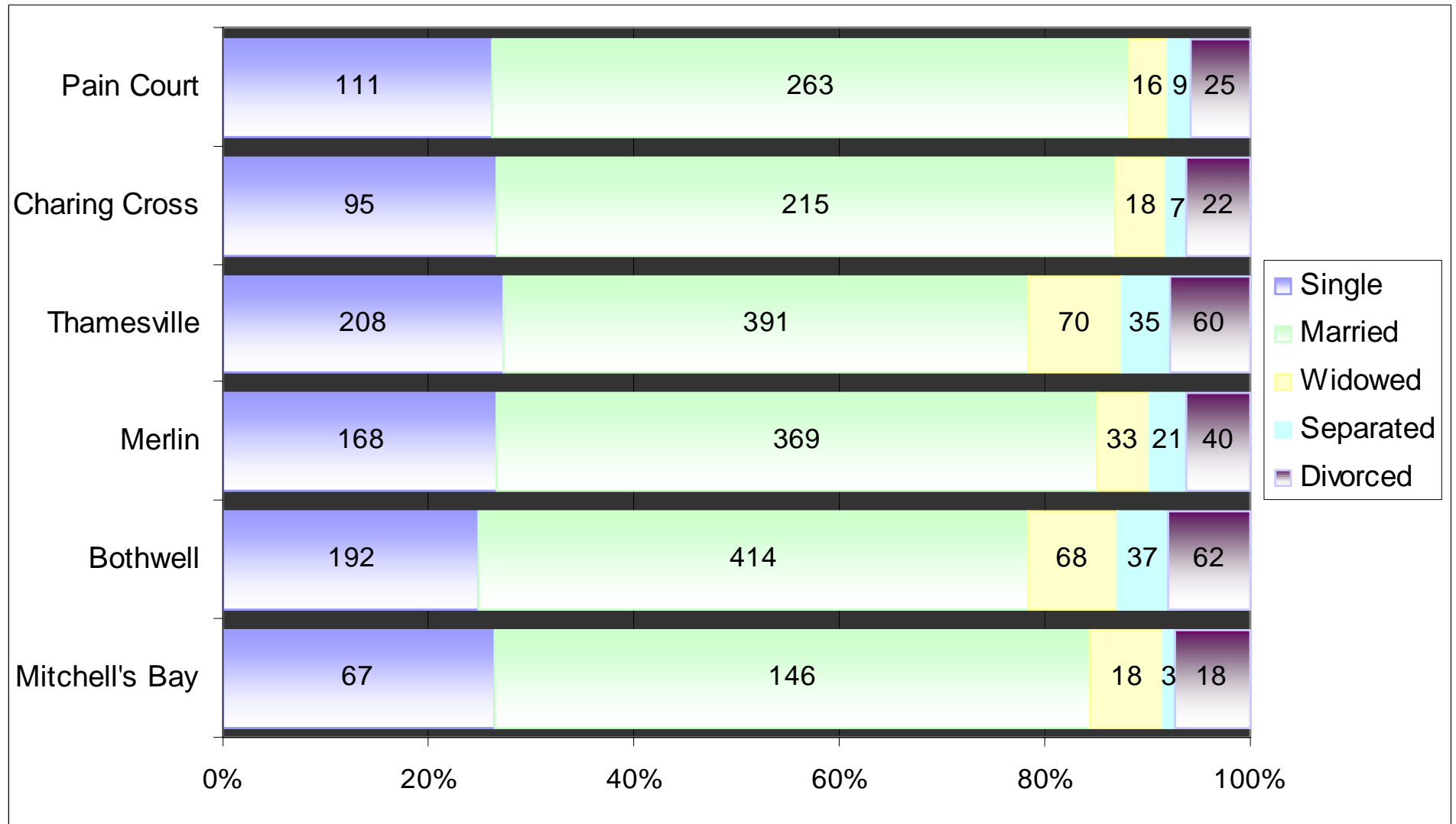
Population by Marital Status for Primary Urban Centres of Chatham-Kent, 2006

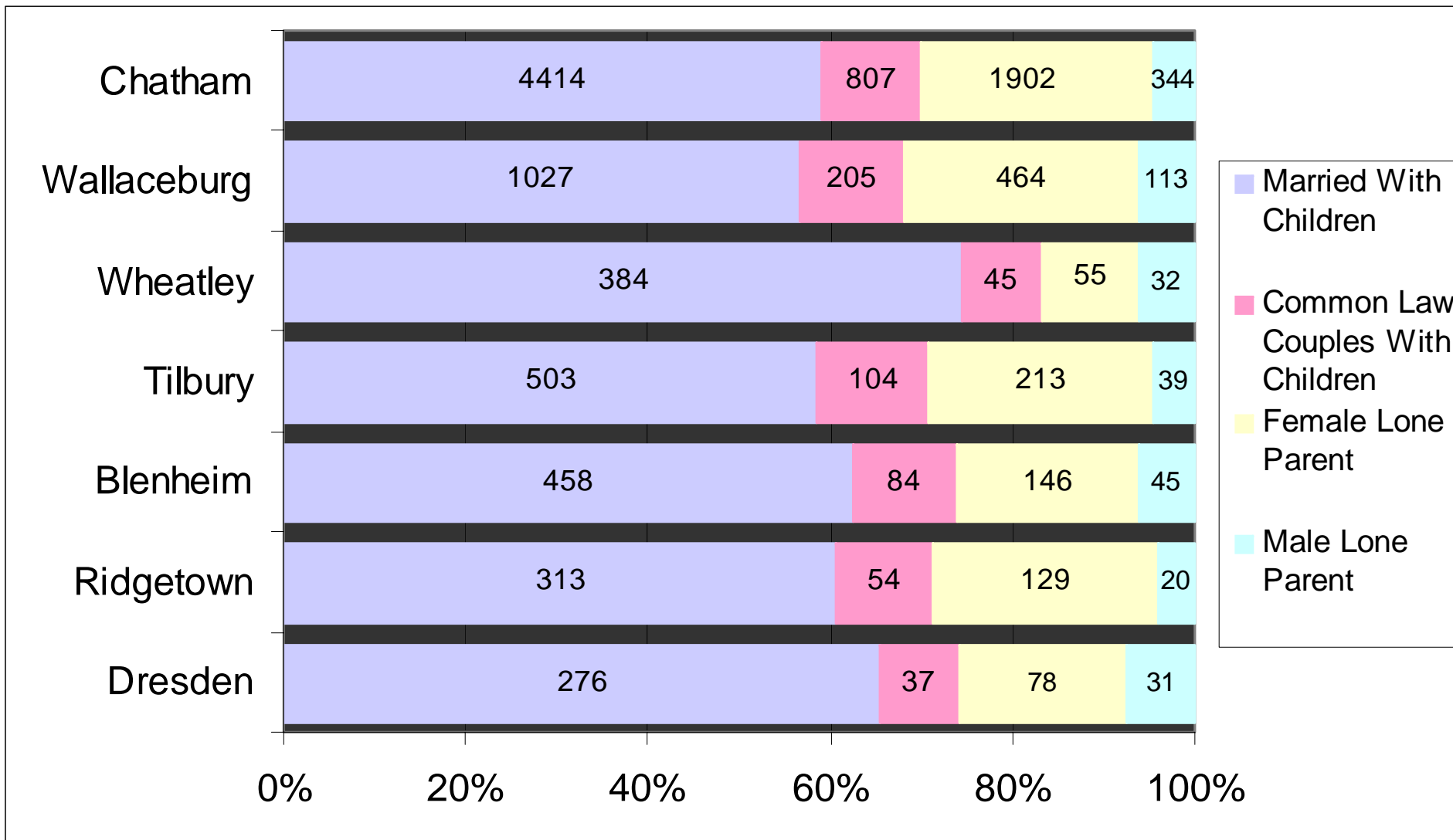

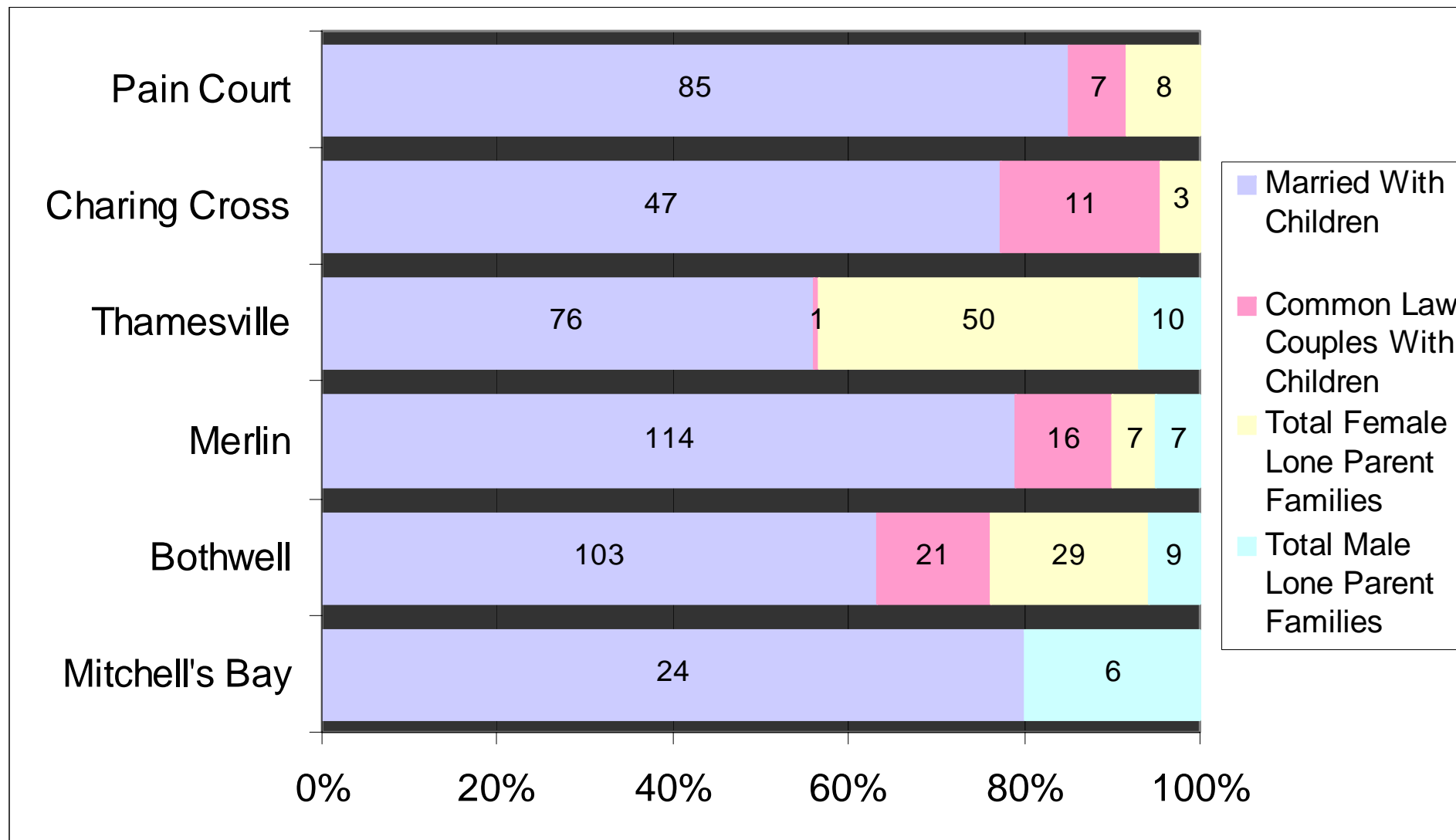
Family Structure for Primary Urban Centres of Chatham-Kent 2006

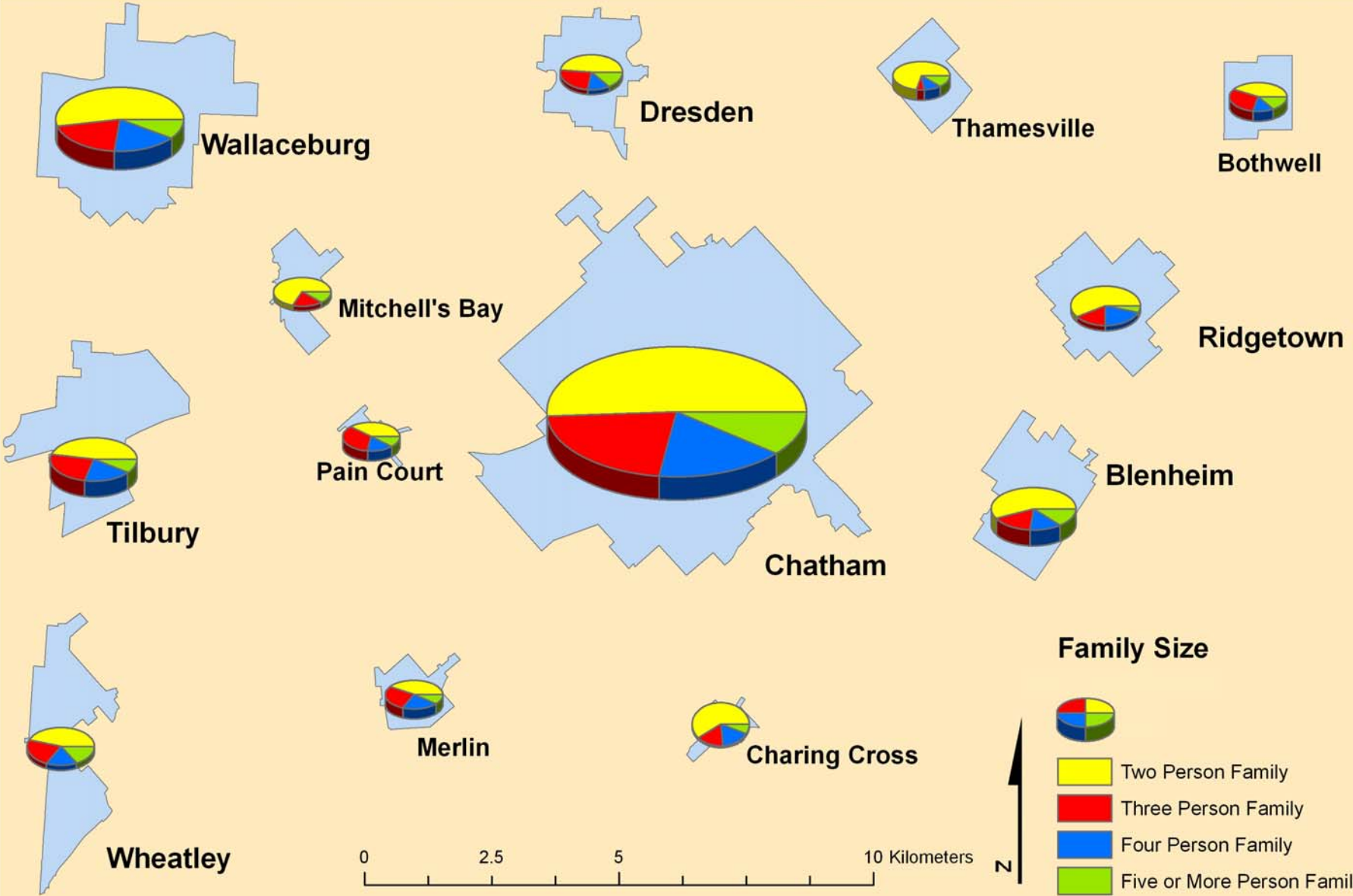
Family Structure for Secondary Urban Centres of Chatham-Kent, 2006

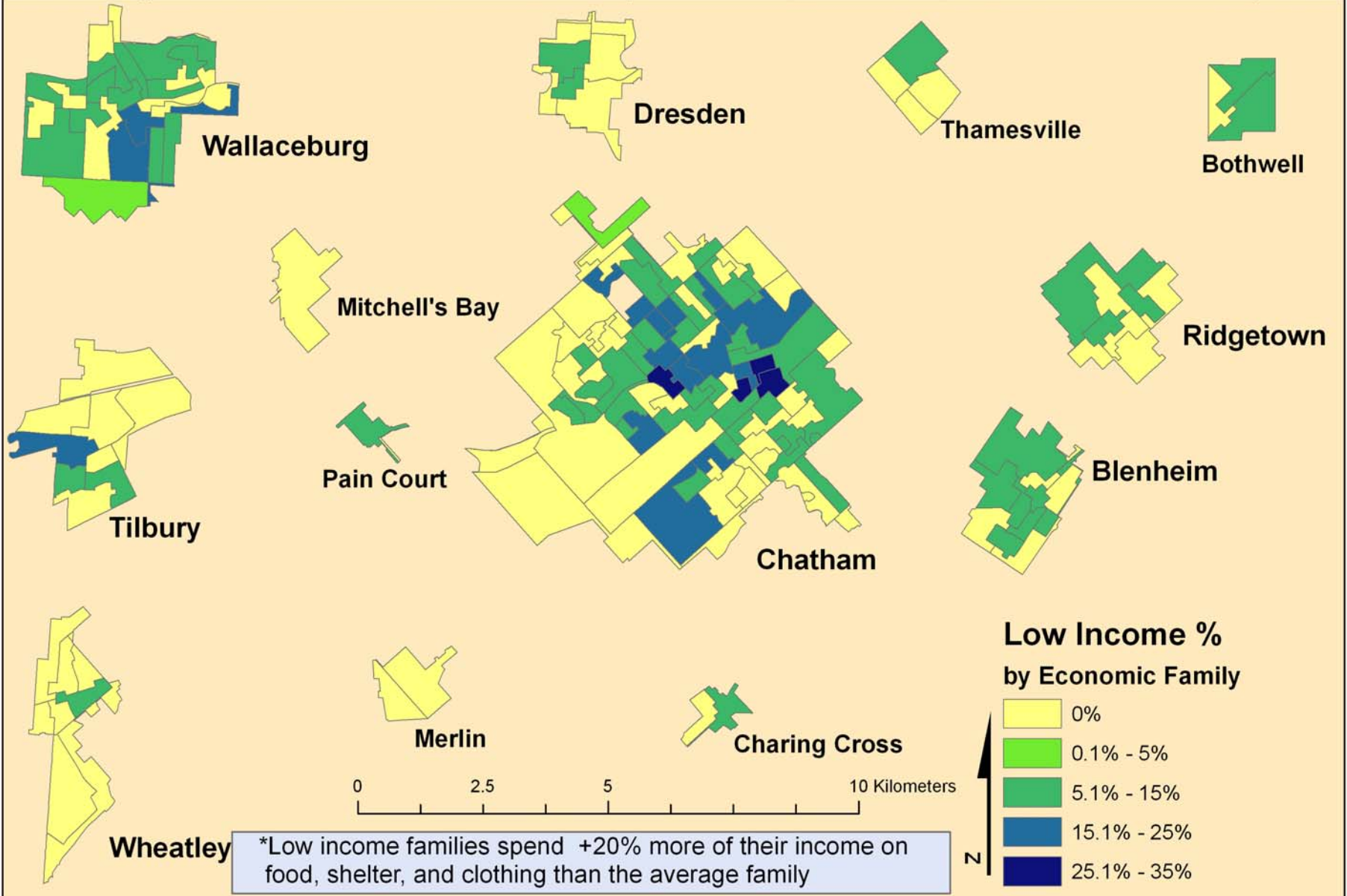

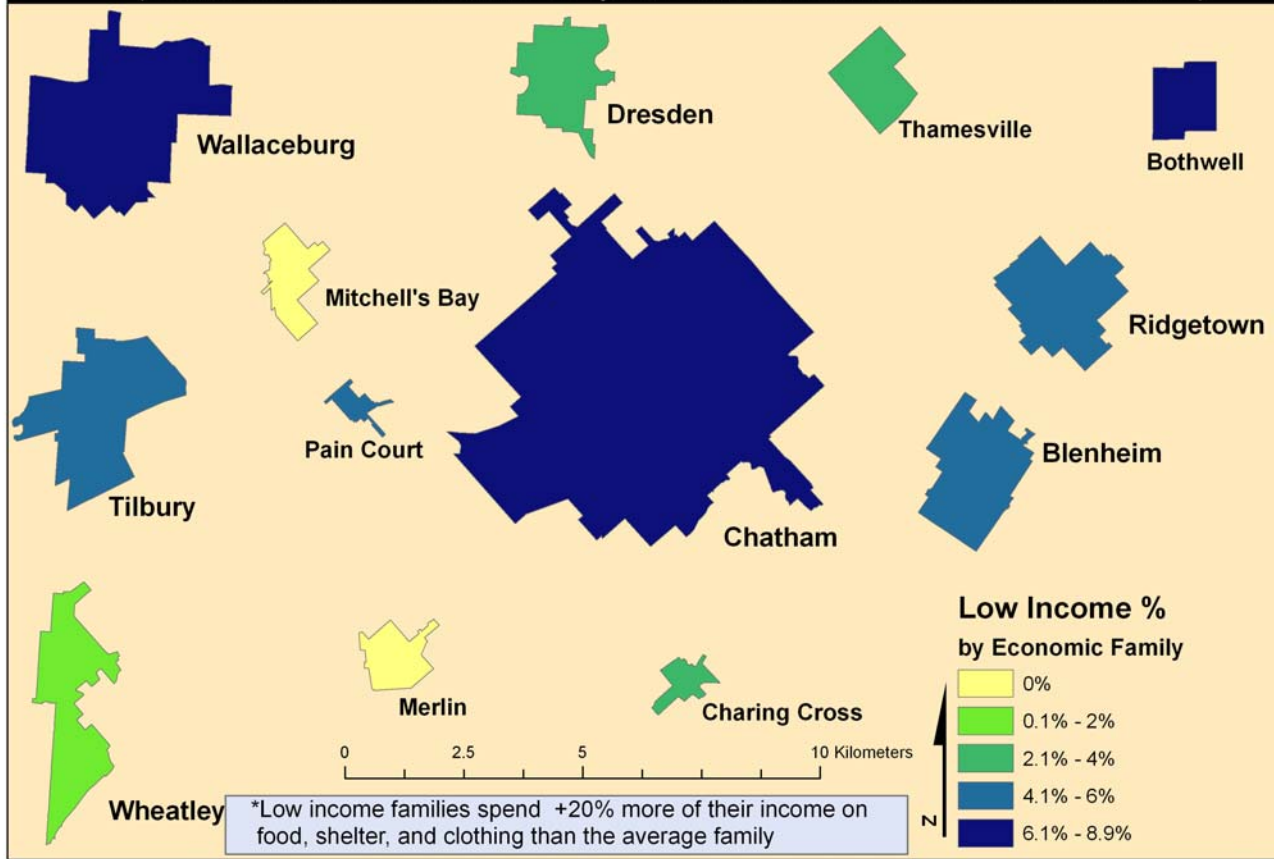
Incidence of Low Income Families* After Tax, 2005

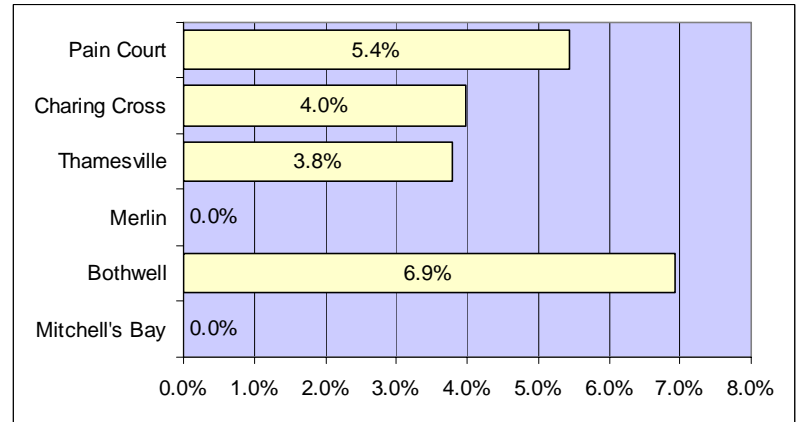
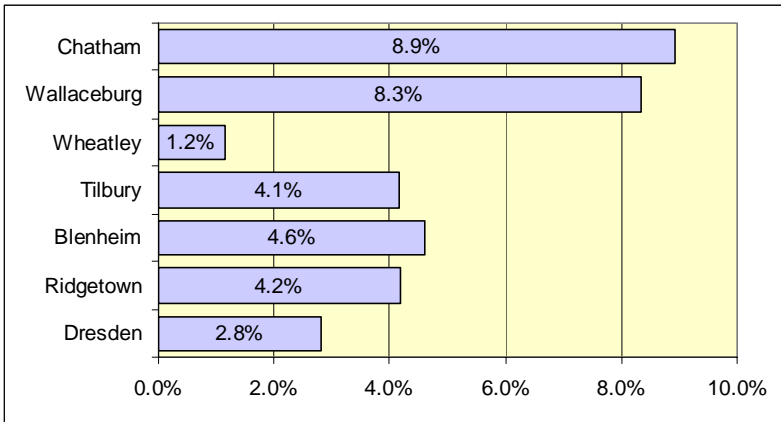
Incidence of Low Income Families* After Tax, 2005

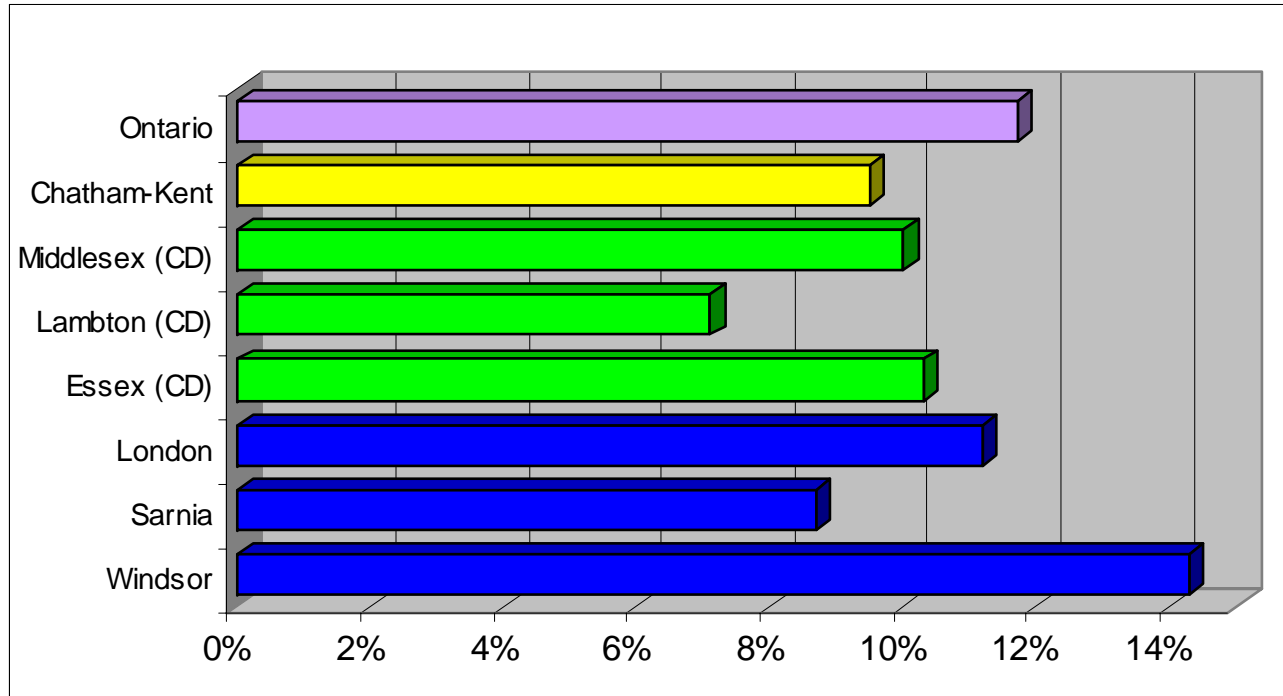

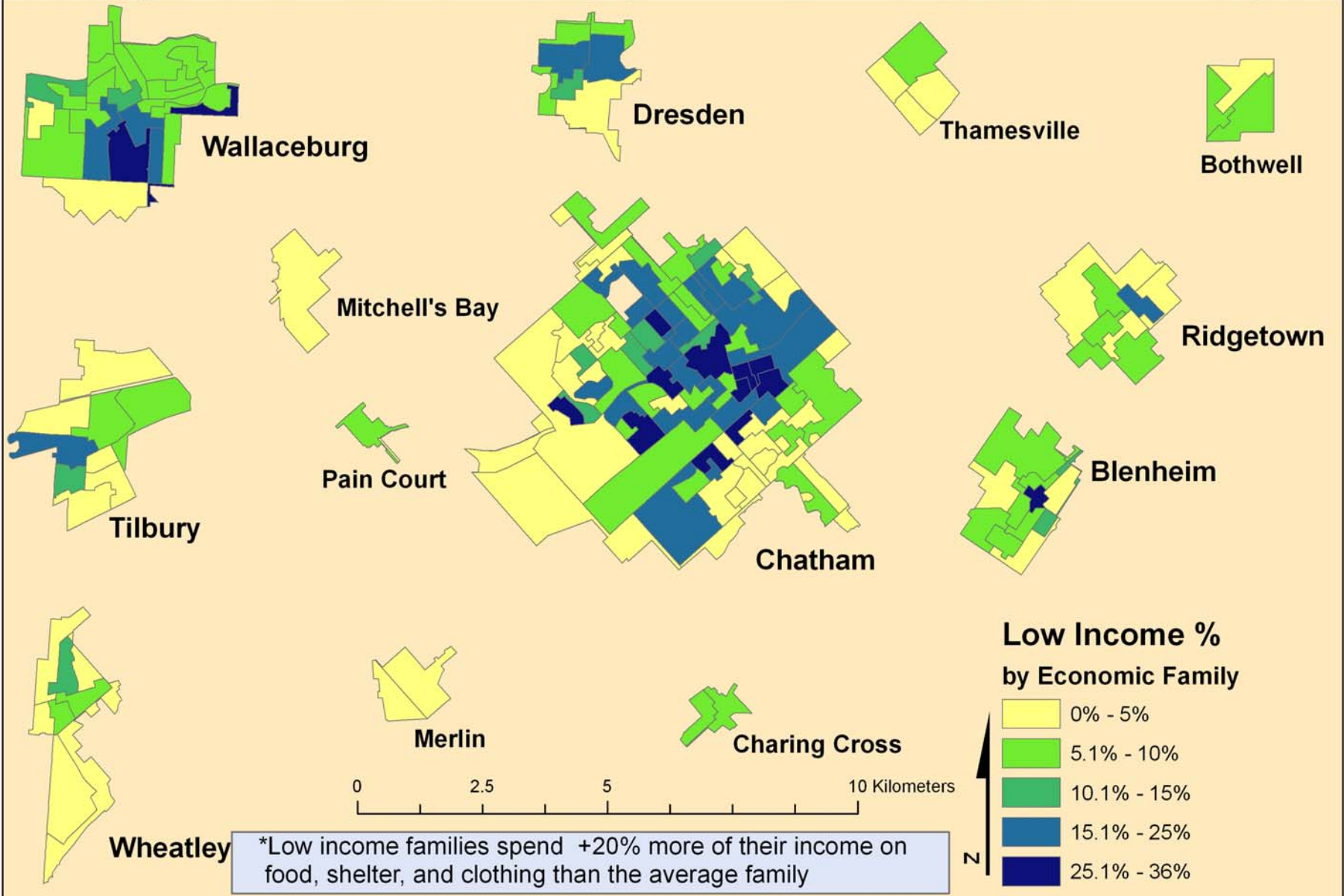

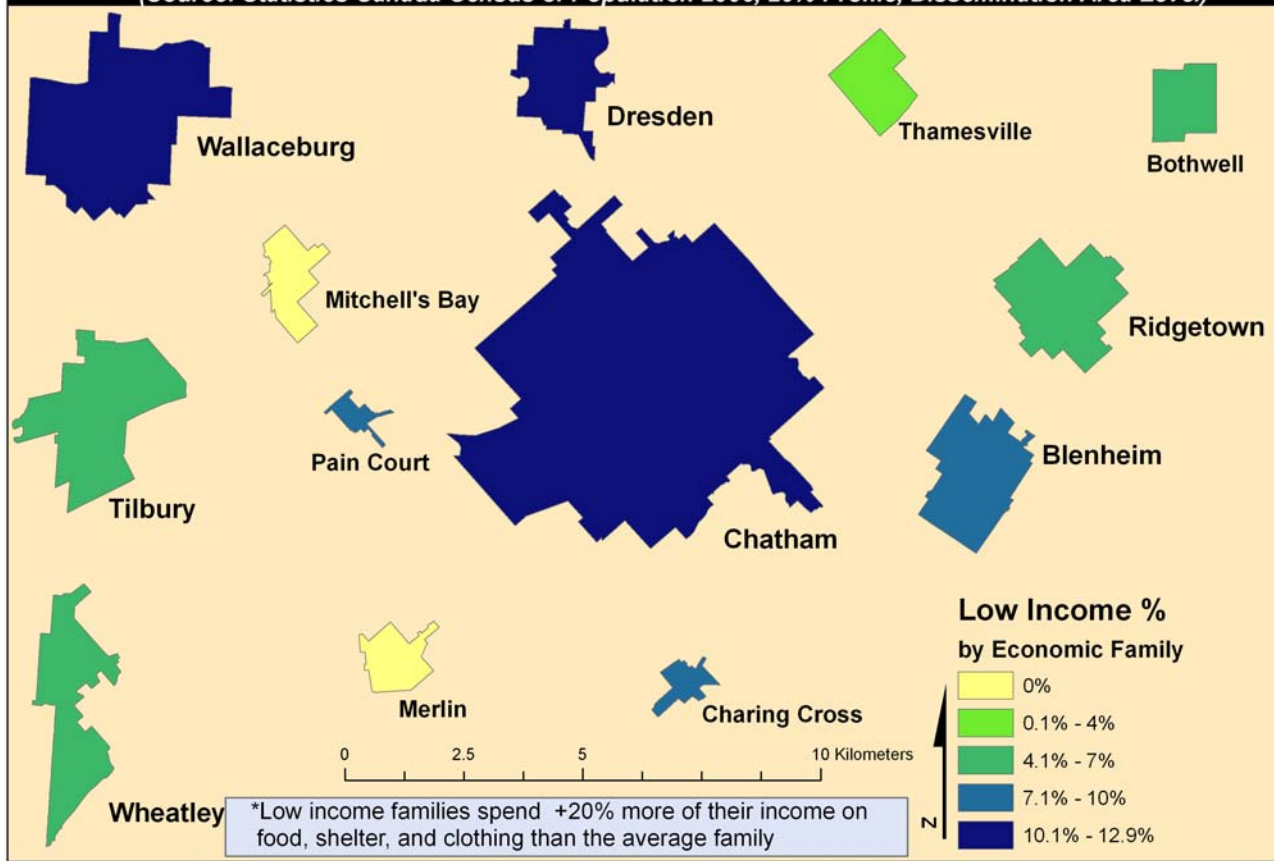
Incidence of Low Income Families* Before Tax, 2005

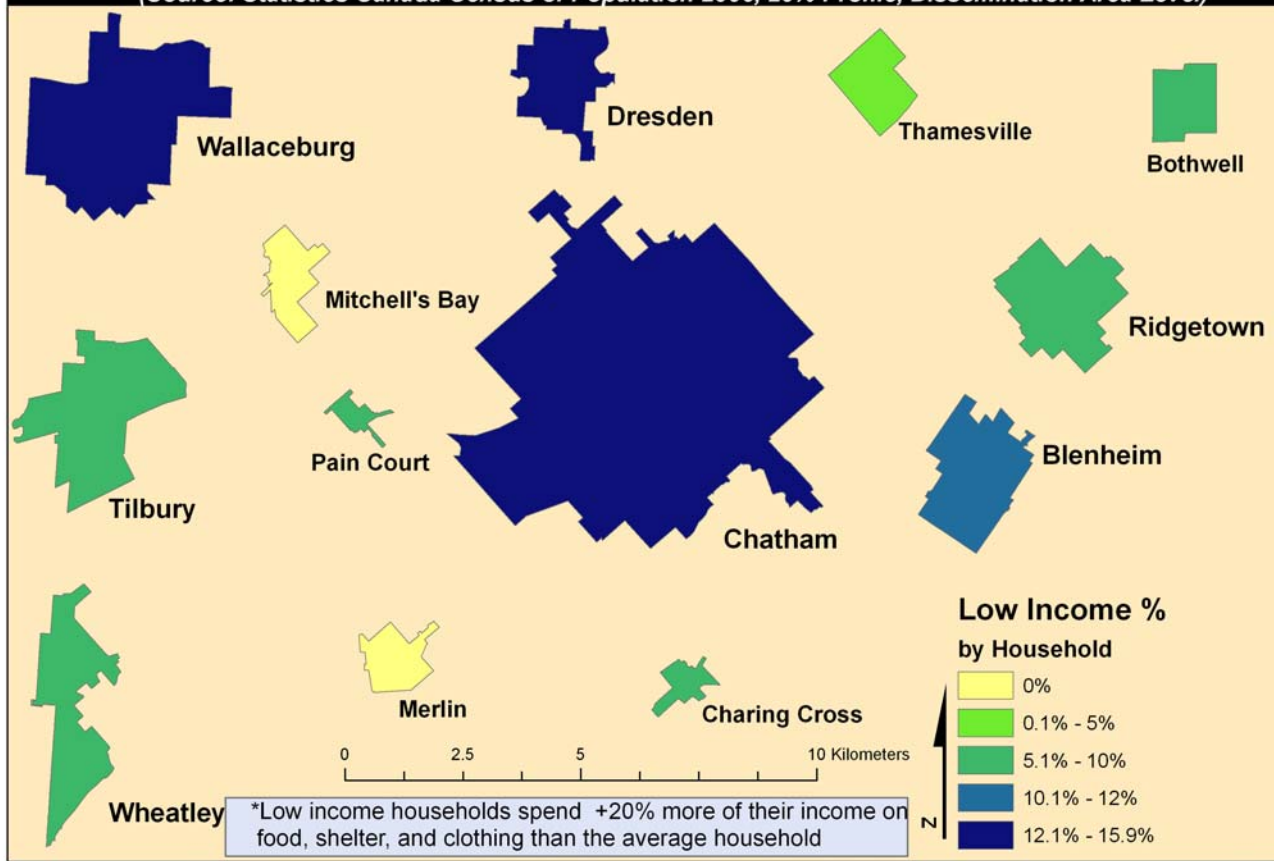
Incidence of Low Income Households* Before Tax, 2005

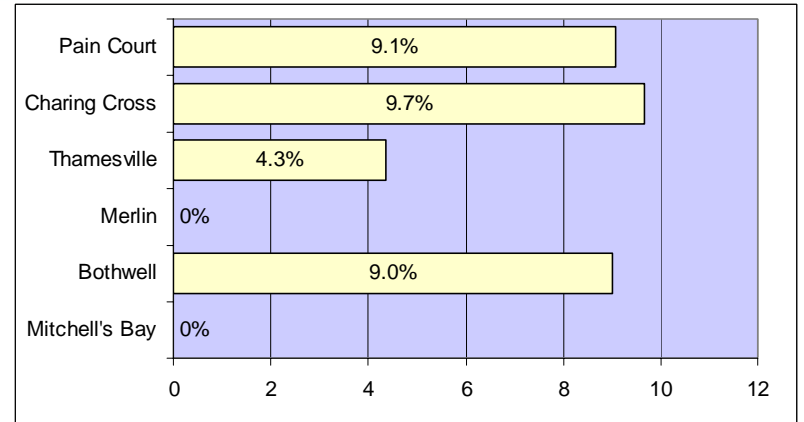
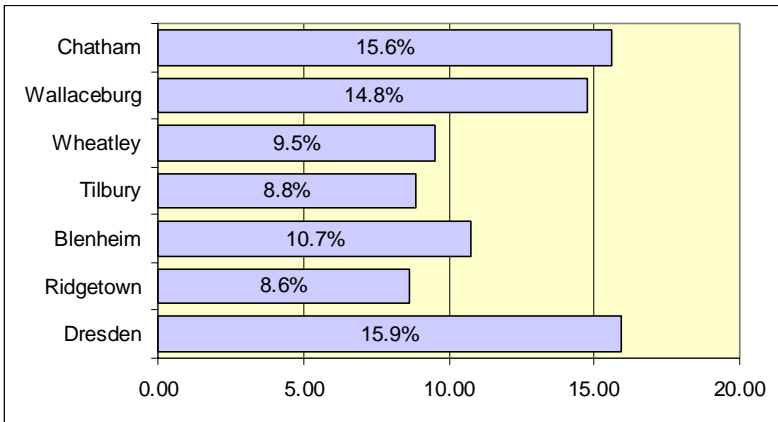
Incidence of Low Income Households* Before Tax, 2005

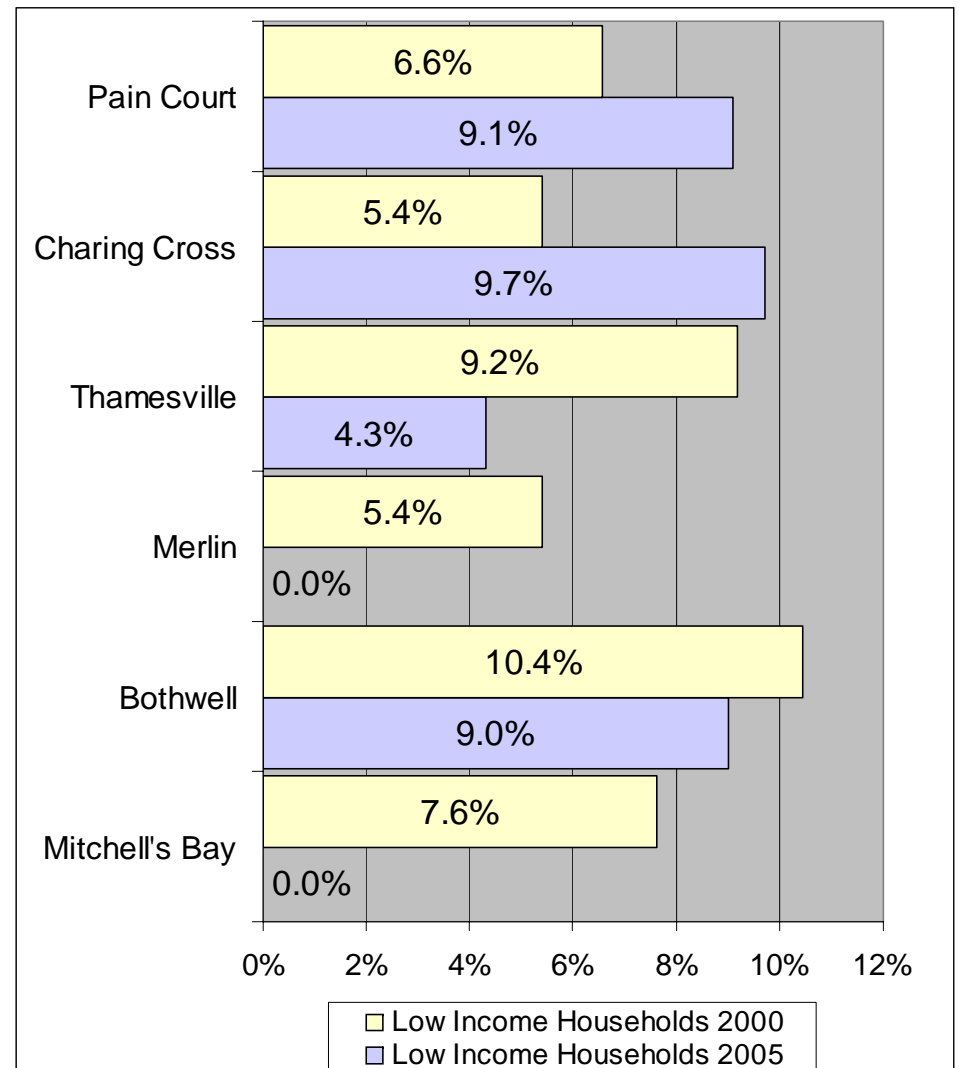
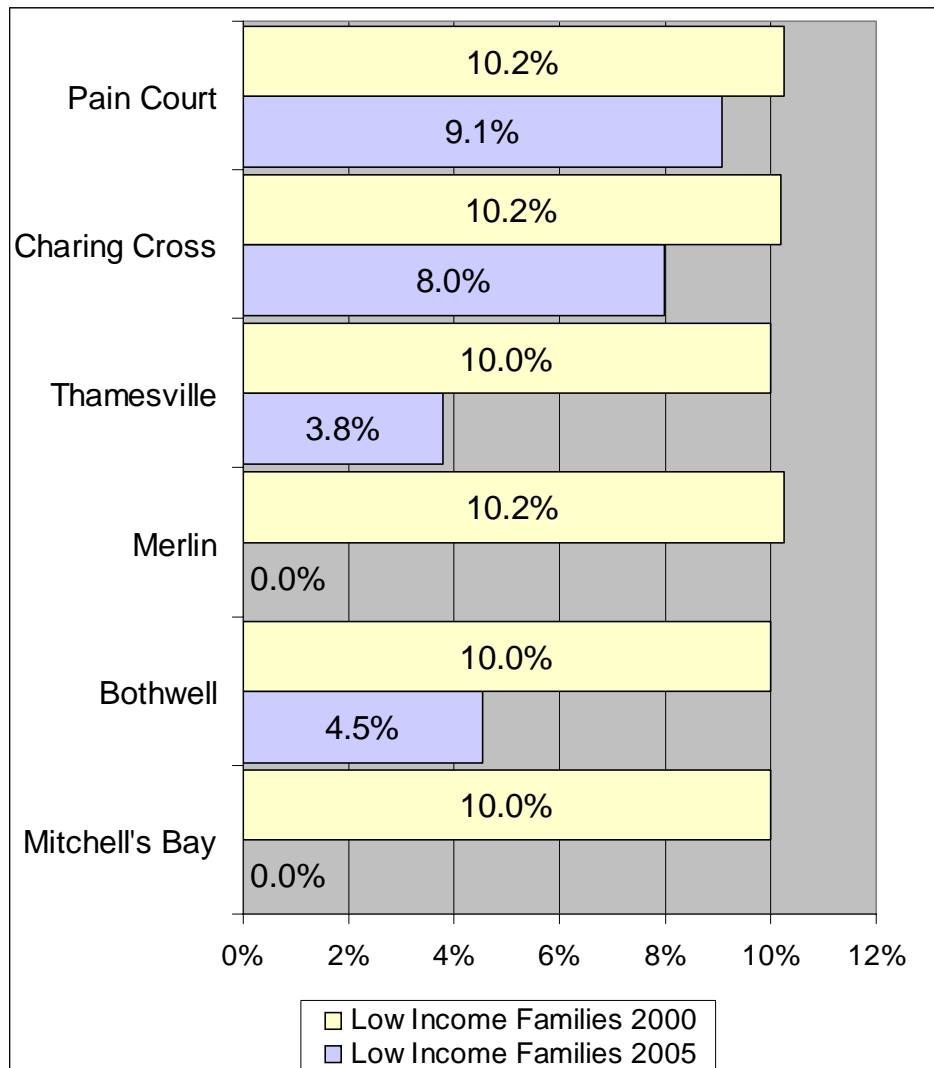
Incidence of Low Income (%) 2000 & 2005 for Primary Urban Centres of Chatham-Kent

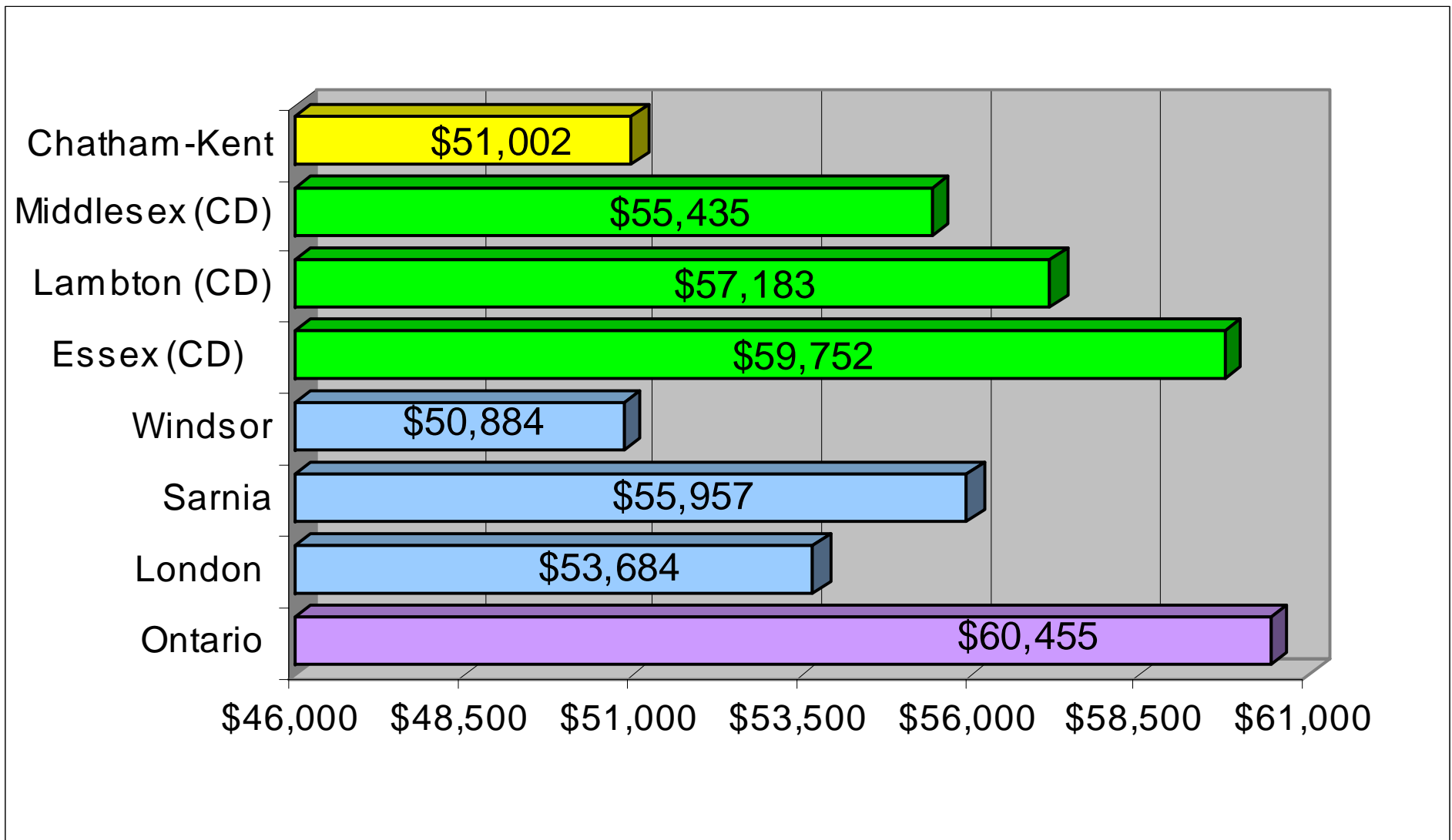
Incidence of Low Income (%) 2000 & 2005 for Secondary Urban Centres of Chatham-Kent

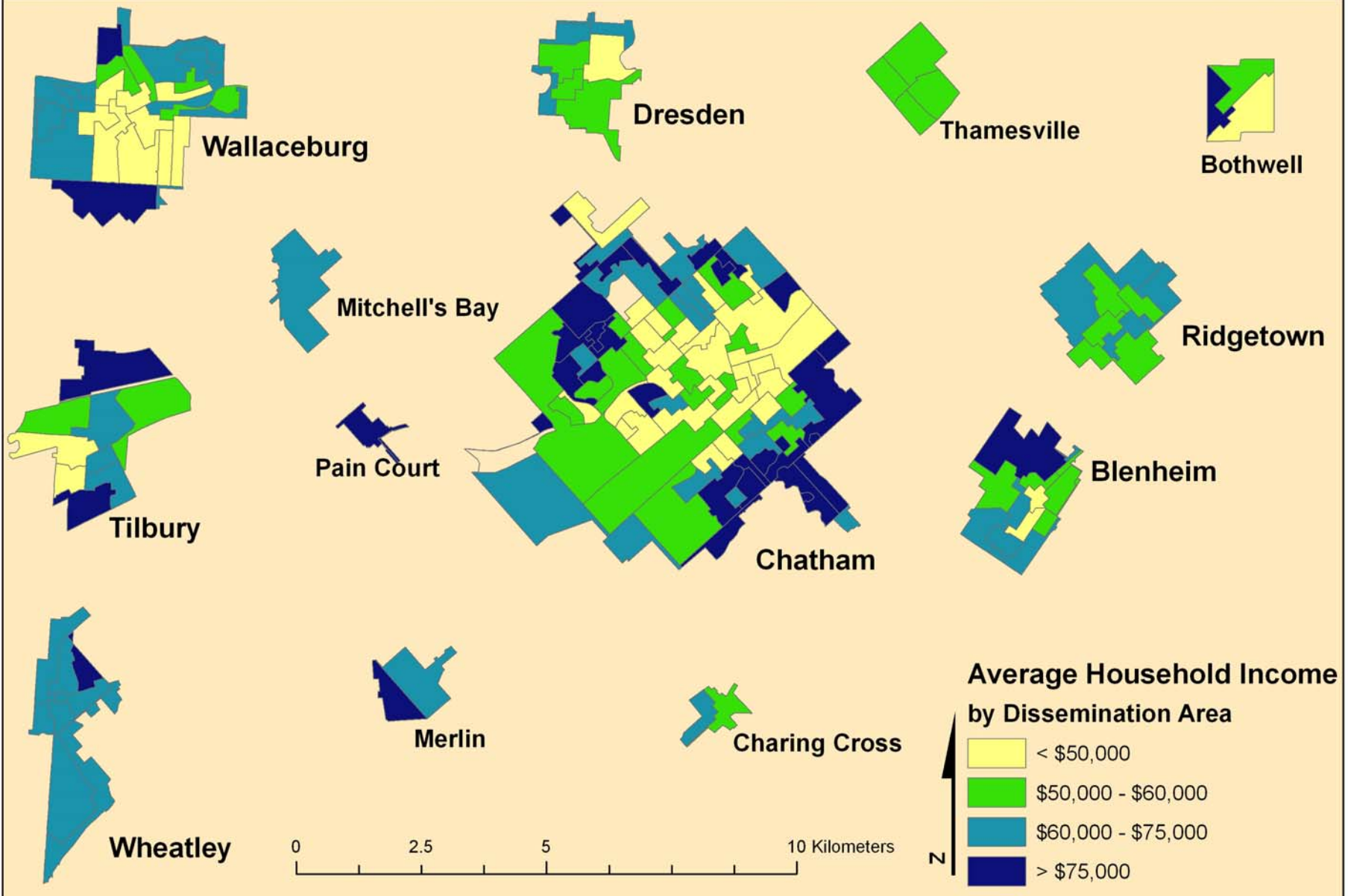
Median Household Income of Chatham-Kent Adjusted for Inflation, 1990-2005

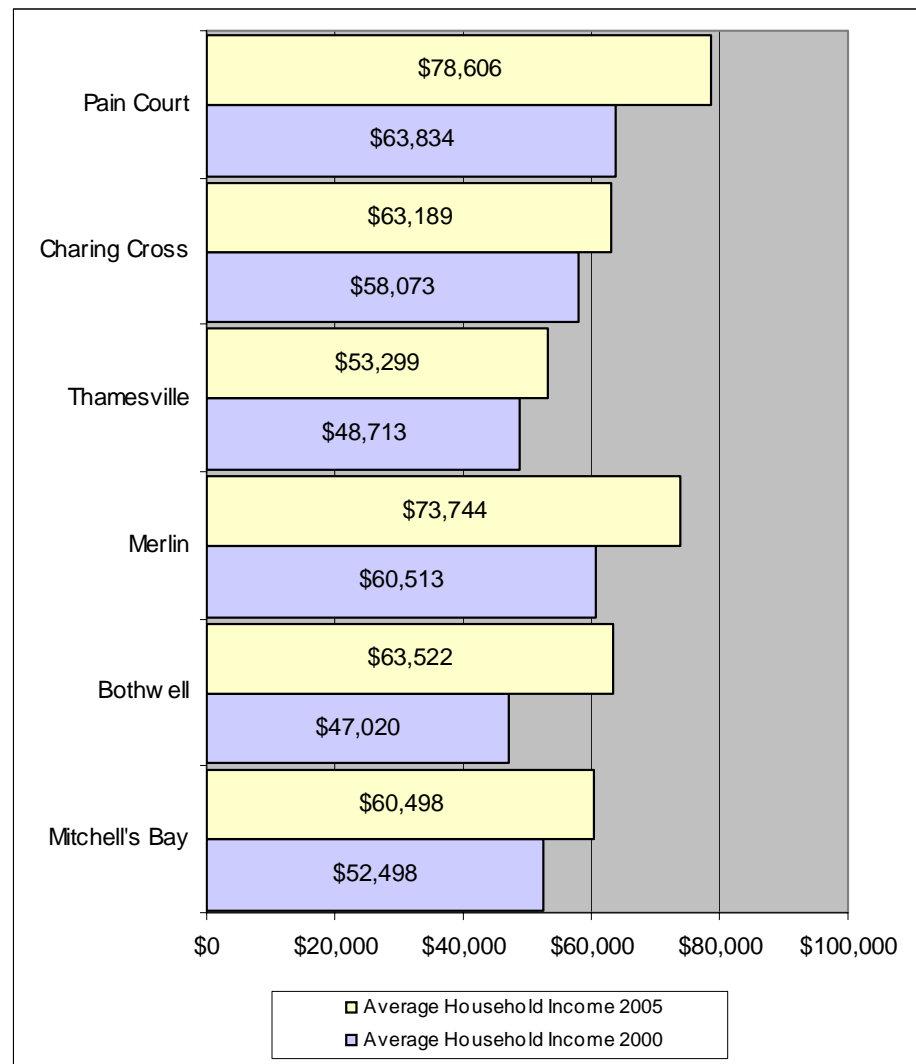
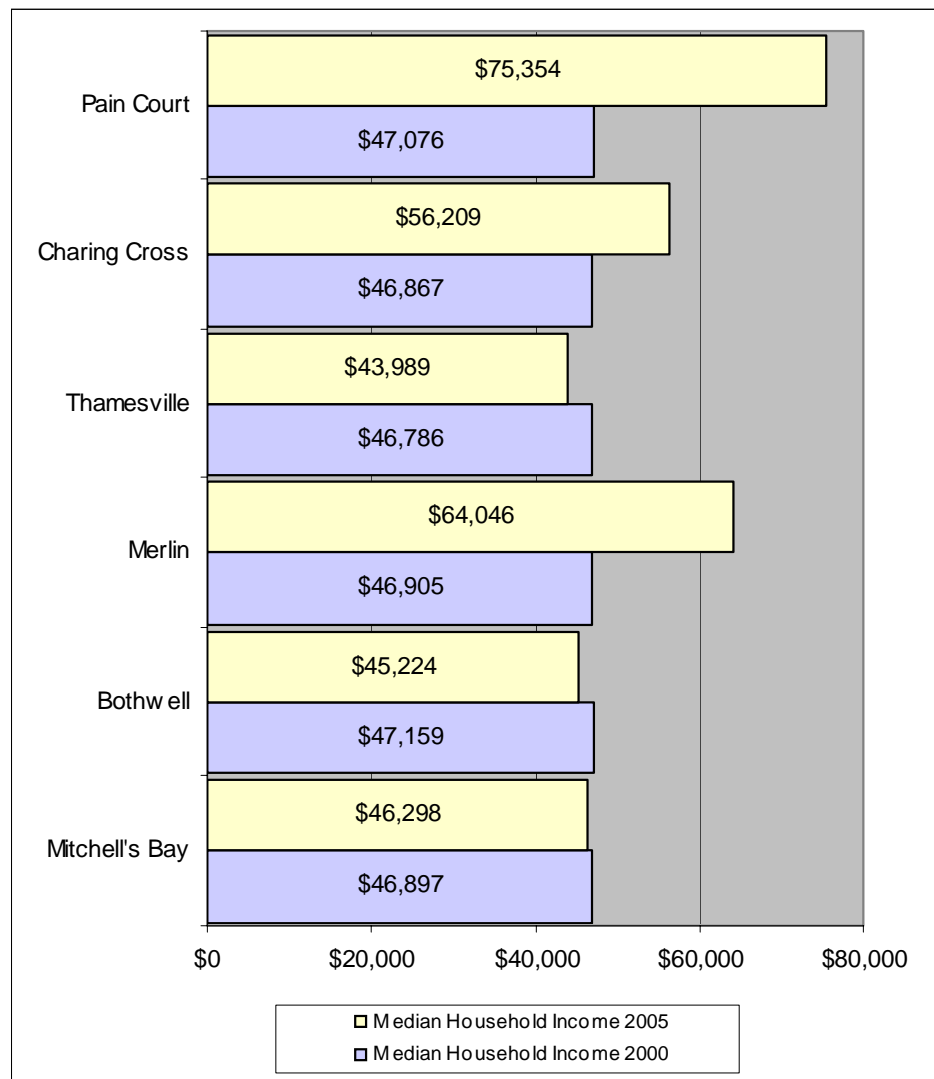
Median and Average Household Income for Primary Urban Centres 2000 & 2005

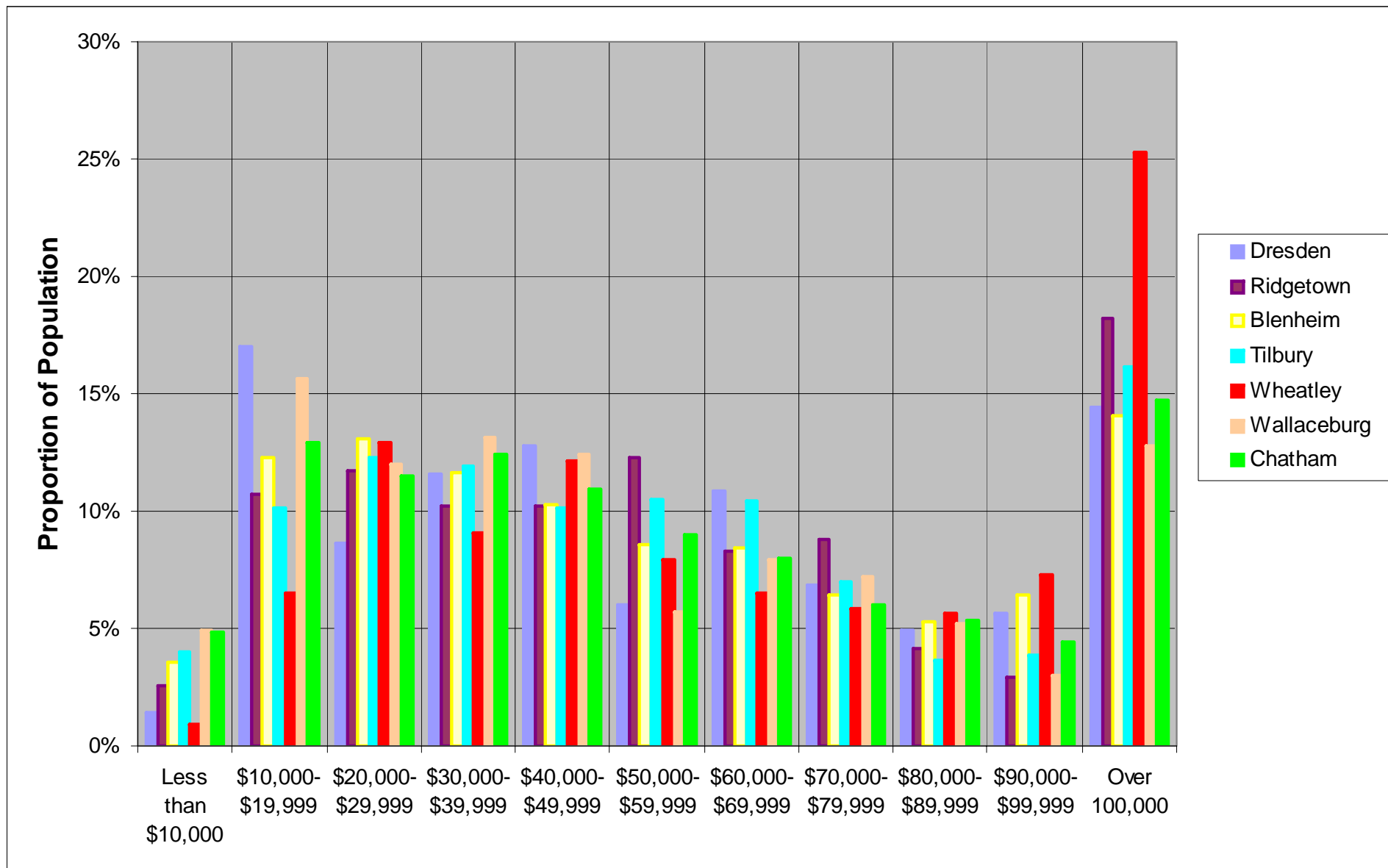
Median and Average Household Income for Secondary Urban Centres 2000 & 2005

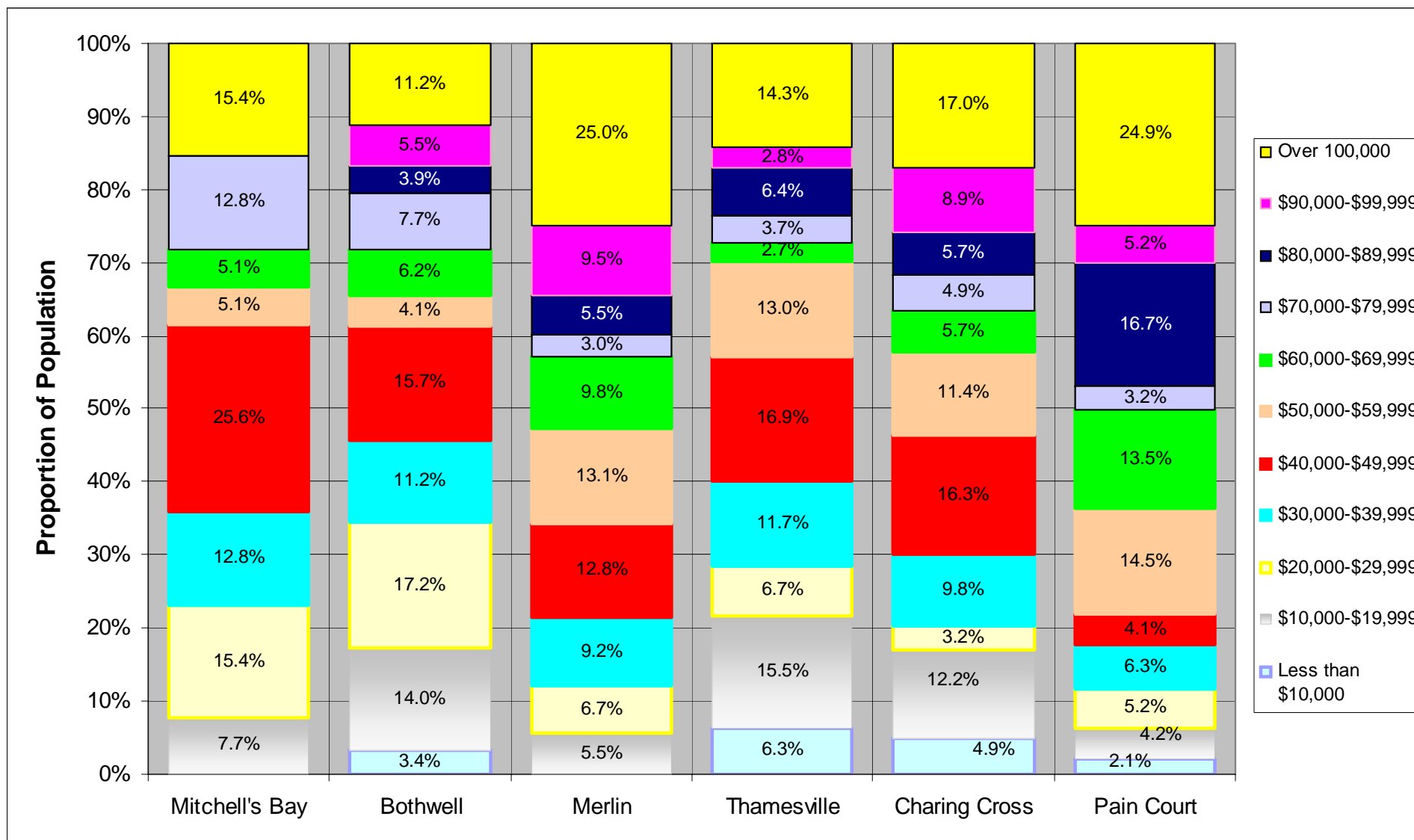

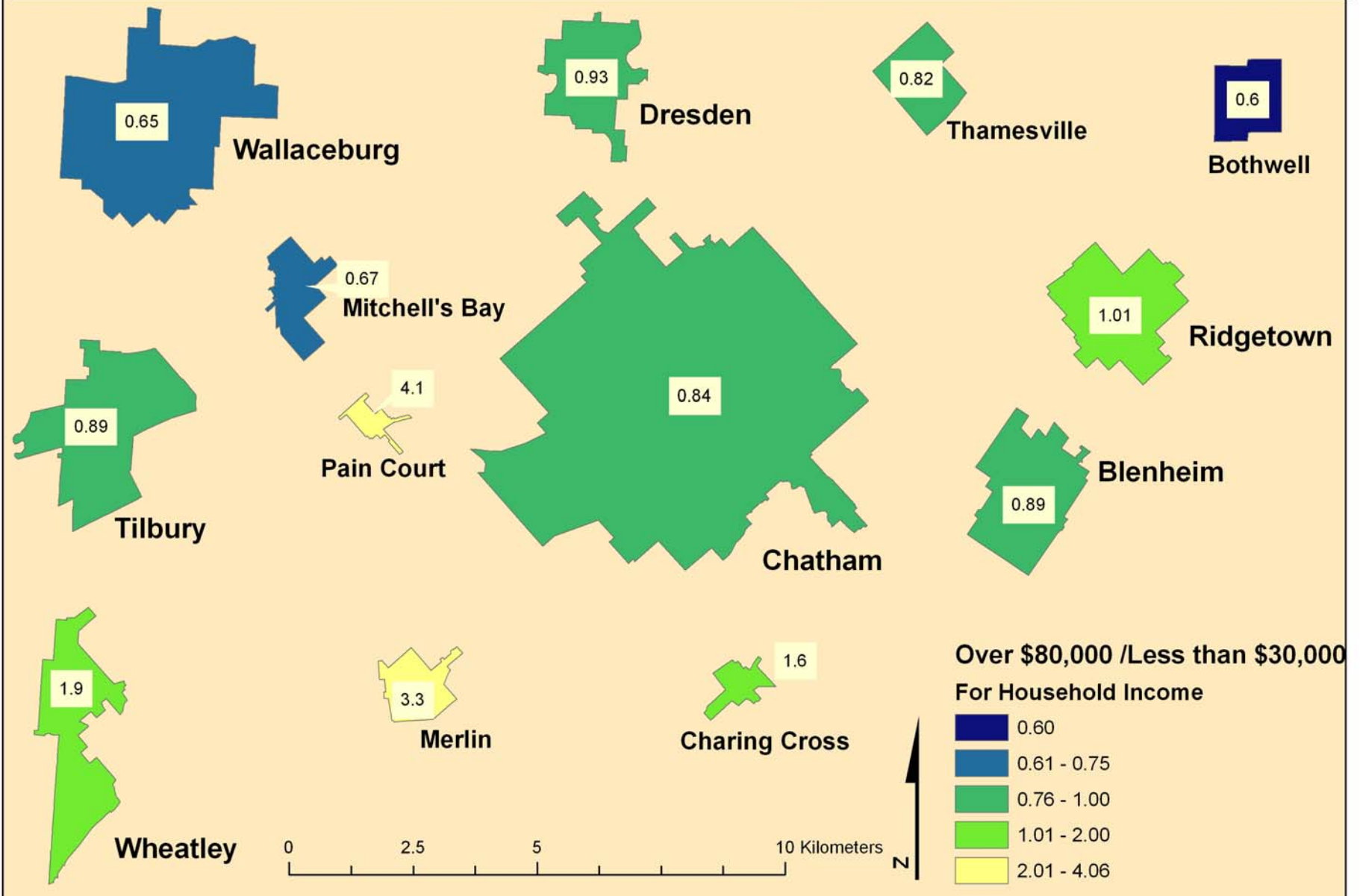
Ratio of Number of Households With Income Over \$80,000 to Households with Income Less than \$30,000, 2005
