REACTIVE: Pool Chemicals, Ammonia, Bleach



FLAMMABLE: Gasoline, Paints, BBQ Starter, Oils, Solvents



TOXIC: Pesticides, Rat Poison, Pharmaceuticals, Cleaning Fluids



CORROSIVE: Battery Acids, Drain Cleaners, Oven Cleaners



BIOHAZARDOUS: Needles ONLY*

FLUORESCENT LIGHTS:
Bulb & Tubes ONLY

•BBQ propane tanks (20 or 30 pounds only) and car batteries will be accepted.

PLEASE NOTE:

If hazardous waste products are thrown in the garbage, they can injure garbage collectors and cause serious environmental damage. Bring these products to the drop-off locations listed above and let the experts handle it for free.

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:

Commercial/Industrial/Agricultural Wastes, Infectious or Radioactive Wastes, PCB's, Ammunition, miscellaneous Propane Cylinders, Batteries and Empty Containers (i.e. pesticide, paint, oil, antifreeze, etc.) will NOT be accepted. **Please visit "Do What You Can" website to find nearest HHW Depot (www.dowhatyoucan.ca) or contact the Municipality for disposal information on non acceptable items.**

HOW:

- All material must be clearly-labelled, sealed containers no larger than 20 litres (Containers will NOT be returned)
- Do not mix different products together
- Needles must be delivered in rigid Puncture-Proof containers (**residents only**)*
- The maximum quantity accepted is a total of 50 litres of waste material.
