EASTER HOLIDAY HOURS

Most municipal offices will be closed on Friday, April 2 and Monday, April 5 for the Easter Holiday weekend. Other services are scheduled as follows:

Emergency Services – Police, Fire and Ambulance are operational 24 hours a day every day and are accessible by dialling “911” for emergency calls only.

Libraries – All public libraries will be closed Friday and Monday and will have normal operational hours on Saturday.

Recreation Facility Operations – On Friday, all arenas are closed.

On Sunday, Thames Campus Arena will be open for limited bookings. All other arenas will be closed.

On Monday, Thames Campus and Tilbury Arenas will be open and all other arenas will be closed.

Blenheim Gable Rees Rotary Pool will be closed on Friday, Saturday and Sunday with normal operating hours resuming on Monday.

Wallaceburg Sydenham Pool will be closed on Friday and Sunday and will have normal operating hours on Saturday and Monday.

Cultural Services – The Thames Art Gallery and Chatham-Kent Museum will be closed on Friday and open from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. The Box Office will be closed Friday through Monday and re-open Tuesday morning at 10:00 a.m. and administration offices will be closed Friday through Monday and re-open Tuesday morning at 9 a.m.

Cemetery Operations will be closed on Friday. Cemetery staff will be on call to handle cemetery business for funeral home operations on Saturday and Monday.

Garbage and Recycling – Collection services for all areas receiving curbside garbage/recycling collection will be delayed by one day for Friday only. There will be regular garbage/recycling collection services for the week of April 5-9. Refer to the 2009-2010 Residential Recycling and Waste Collection Calendar for further details.

Transfer Stations - The Wallaceburg and Harwich Transfer Stations will be closed on Friday and will be open regular hours on Monday. Transfer Stations that are regularly open on Saturdays (Camden, Chatham Twp., Dover, Harwich, Howard, Orford, Tilbury East and Wallaceburg) will be open for regular hours on Saturday.

Chatham Leaf and Yard Depot - Will be closed on Friday and will be open regular hours on Monday.

Public Health Services (including Clinic Services located at 177 King Street East, Chatham) - These services are closed Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Essential public health services are available by calling 1-866-446-8207.

Child Care Learning Centres (Wallaceburg and May Court) – These centres are closed Friday, April 2 and re-open on Monday, April 5

Riverview Gardens – Administrative offices will be closed Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday, but visiting hours continue as normal over the holiday weekend.

Chatham-Kent Energy, Hydro, Utility and PUC will be closed Friday through Monday inclusive. The emergency call number is 519-352-6300.
