CK Pool Policies

- Mutual appreciation and respect between CK staff and users.
- Upon hearing thunder or seeing lightning the pool will be cleared and closed for 30 minutes.
- Your belongings are your responsibility.

CK Pool Rules

- Walk on deck to avoid injury.
- Hands-off environment. (horseplay, pushing, hitting, launching, dunking, and shoulder rides etc. are not permitted)
- Plastic water bottles only.
- Shoes to be removed upon entering the deck area.
- Life jackets to be fitted by pool staff to ensure the appropriate fit. (Jump test-ask us about it!)
- Water wings must stay in the shallow end. Parents/guardians must be within arm's reach.
- Infants/toddlers must wear little swimmers.
- Everyone must jump or dive forward, 1 bounce, feet/arms first.
- 1 person on the board at a time.
- 3 step take off is acceptable. (jumping or diving)

The National Lifeguards Primary Role is to:

- Prevent emergency situations including incidents and injury.
- Promote water safety education.
- Provide leadership to the community.

The Consequences


1. Verbal warning that the rule has not been followed.
2. You will be asked to leave that swim.
3. The police will be contacted and the pool will be closed.

Swimming Lessons Cancellation Policy

- All swimming lesson classes require a minimum of 2 registrants for the program to run.
- In the event of insufficient registration, there will be the option:
 1. To transfer to another timeslot if available
 2. Take the equivalent value in private lessons
 3. Receive a full refund/credit.



Admission Standards for Public Pools

CHILDREN 10 YEARS AND OLDER	CHILDREN 6 TO 9 YEARS	CHILDREN 5 YEARS AND UNDER
May swim without parent or guardian accompaniment.	Must be accompanied in the water by a parent or guardian (min. 12 yrs of age)	Must be accompanied in the water by a parent or adult guardian (min. 16 yrs of age)
Recommended to always "Swim With a Buddy" 	Parent/guardian is responsible for their direct supervision.	Parent/ guardian is responsible for their direct supervision and must be within arms reach of the child at all times.
	Non-swimmers must remain within arms reach of their parent/guardian.	Maximum of 3 children per parent/adult guardian.
	Children with a completion of AQ4 or higher or of the recommendation of a lifeguard.
