


2 - Stream Recycling Guide

2-Stream recycling means you separate paper products from all other recyclables. Use two containers, black box for Fibres (e.g. paper & boxboard) and blue box for all other recyclables. Place all excess paper including small amounts of shredded paper in an un-tied plastic/paper grocery bag in or beside your fibre recycling box.




STREAM 1 Fibre Products Only




STREAM 2 Food, Beverage & Liquid Containers

Household Paper:


includes mail, white & coloured paper and envelopes.

 **Do not** recycle milk and juice cartons, drink boxes, coffee cups and waxed, foil, laminated or gift wrap paper.




Newspapers and Telephone Books:

includes inserts/flyers.




Paper Egg Cartons and Boxes:

such as cereal, tissue, detergent, cracker and shoe boxes. Remove liners and flatten.




Magazines, Catalogues and Books:

includes hard (remove the cover) and soft cover books and glossy publications.




Cardboard Boxes:


Break down, flatten and tie in bundles no larger than 75 cm x 75 cm x 20 cm (30" x 30" x 8"). Please remove food residue and liners from pizza boxes.



Glass Bottles and Jars:


Please remove food and rinse.


 **Do not** recycle broken glass, drinking glasses, dishes, cups, other ceramics, window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, pottery, glass pots & pans.



Aluminum and Steel Cans:


Place lids inside. Please rinse.

 **Do not** recycle aerosol cans, paint cans, coat hangers, pots, needles and batteries.






NEW Aluminum Foil Containers and Foil:


Pie plates, trays/baking pans and take-out food containers. Please remove/rinse food and flatten.




Plastic Bottles, Jugs and Tubs:

Plastic household rigid containers and tubs with numbers  or  or 

Look on the bottom of the container. Remove caps and lids. Flatten to make more room.

 **Do not** recycle toys, Styrofoam™, plastic wrap and bags, flower trays, used oil containers, cookie/egg containers and unmarked plastics.



Recycling Don'ts

- ◆ **Don't** mix Stream 1 and Stream 2 materials in the same container
- ◆ **Don't** use cardboard boxes, laundry baskets, milk crates to hold your materials
- ◆ **Don't** exceed 18 kg (40 lbs) of materials placed in any one container

DO NOT Recycle These Materials at Curbside

Paper: milk and juice cartons, drink boxes, coffee cups, waxed or foil coated paper or boxes and wrapping paper

Glass: broken glass, drinking glasses, dishes, cups, other ceramics, crystal, window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, pottery, glass pots and pans

Plastic: toys, Styrofoam™, plastic wrap and bags, plant pots, used oil containers, dish pails

Metal: spray cans, paint cans, coat hangers, pots and batteries

Pesticides: pesticides and other household special waste containers

Do not place needles with your recyclables or garbage. They can be dangerous for neighbourhood children and collection staff. Place them in a hard plastic container and contact a local pharmacy or the Chatham-Kent Health Unit for disposal information.
