### THAMES ART GALLERY

The Thames Art Gallery is dedicated to promoting the understanding, appreciation, and conservation of the visual arts for present and future generations in Chatham-Kent. Each year the Gallery hosts 12-15 exhibitions highlighting both historical and contemporary artwork by local, national, and international artists. Specialized arts education programs are offered for children and adults year-round through summer art camps, March break and PA Day programs, Saturday workshops, and evening classes. The Thames Art Gallery is open 7 days a week from 1pm - 5pm.

### KIWANIS THEATRE

This 700-seat theatre offers surprising intimacy of space and is home to many community organizations such as *Theatre Kent*. The Kiwanis Theatre continues to host many top Canadian performers, with special emphasis on our home-grown talent. Local artists Jade Lester, Tom Lockwood, and Ken Crone delight audiences on a regular basis and are a wonderful addition to the *Encore Series* offerings.



### CHATHAM-KENT MUSEUM

As you pass through the Harrison Hall arch, you will enter into a world rich in the history of Chatham-Kent. Since 1943, the Chatham-Kent Museum has been dedicated to collecting and preserving the material heritage of Chatham-Kent and to promoting the area's history through exhibits and programming. Over the past six decades, the museum has assembled an interesting and diverse collection that includes military items, prehistoric artifacts, and a world-famous Egyptian Mummy! School programs are available. The Chatham-Kent Museum is open 7 days a week from 1pm - 5pm.

### RIDGE HOUSE MUSEUM

Built in 1874 by local tradesmen, Ridge House Museum is a typical middle-class home of the 1870's. It even features a historic vegetable garden! Costumed interpreters at Ridge House Museum take visitors back to 1875. The modern display gallery exhibits collections of artifacts, and folk art and the Gallery displays are changed about every six weeks. Ridge House Museum is located on Erie Street in friendly Ridgetown. Outreach programs, school programs, group tours, and special programs are available all year by appointment. Ridge House Museum is open daily from 1pm - 5pm, March to September, and for the month of December until Christmas.

### MILNER HERITAGE HOUSE

Robert Milner and his wife Emma built this Queen Anne-style residence in 1894. In 1943, Robert and Emma's children donated the house to the City of Chatham. The restored Milner Heritage House depicts the turn-of-the-century lifestyle of a successful industrialist and his family. Costumed interpreters take visitors back in time to 1905 when stereoscopes, gramophones, and magic lanterns were a family's means of entertainment, and a 'modern' kitchen consisted of a wood stove, ice box, and a new, all-purpose "Chatham" cupboard. Milner Heritage House is open from Victoria Day weekend to Labour Day, daily from 1pm - 5pm.
